EDITORIAL NOTES

It is a fact of interest that with a population that ranks 28th among the countries of the world, Canada is fifth in total exports and third in total turnover of trade.

Those who would rally all that is possible to the support of the Liquor Control Act have tried to construe a speech of the Ontario Liberal leader as voicing approval of the Act as now being carried out in Ontario.

From returns so far made it appears that the maple sugar yield in the Province of Quebec, the principal sources of production in Canada, was this year a bumper one.

A sample shipment of Canadian eggs to Buenos Aires, Argentina, made by the Canadian Federal Department of Agriculture has, according to cable advice of the Canadian Government Trade Commissioner there, created a very favorable impression among the buyers and the prospects for a good market for eggs from the Dominion in the Argentine are encouraging.

Of the 2,750,000 acres taken up by settlers in Canada in 1928 eight per cent was in such northerly districts as Prince Albert, Saskatchewan, and the Peace River district, Alberta.

The action of Sir Esme Howard in voluntarily making the British Embassy in Washington come under the same standing as other parts of the capital, regardless of privileges that might be retained will do much toward showing a friendly desire to observe the laws of the country in which the embassy is maintained.

With such an example from the higher-ups the masses will undoubtedly have more respect for the prohibition law.
