It takes 3 to complete a call. If one slips, the call fails. THERE are three people to every telephone call. If any one of them makes a mistake the person calling, it may be the person called. There are over one million local calls in Ontario and Quebec every day which fail - "Line's Busy" or "No Answer" - "No one on the line now etc." "Wrong Number". These uncompleted calls are a serious traffic congestion of traffic - constant irritation - a headache to efficient service. Some of these cannot be avoided and some of them are due to carelessness, and many of them are due to lack of co-operation by the other two parties. We are constantly reducing our own errors and we are constantly striving to give the best possible telephone service at lowest possible cost. As part of this effort we are now giving publicity to common faults in telephone usage in the hope that there may be mutual endeavor to secure and maintain maximum efficiency. It takes three people to complete a call - If one makes a mistake, the call fails.
