Immediately after the ceremony Mr. and Mrs. English left on a short wedding trip. They will reside on the groom's farm, "Crofton Villa," Guelph.

**Klanman Tried Hunger Strike**  
Dr. W. A. Phillips, of Hamilton, complained in the Kix Klix Klan case, who began a three month hunger strike in the Hamilton County Jail at Milton two weeks ago Wednesday, is still on a hunger strike, which he began some days ago. His meals are placed before him three times a day and he refuses to eat. Governor McRobb states that after several visits to Phillips by his fellow-Klanmen the prisoner's cell is thoroughly searched to make sure that no food is smuggled in. The Klan leader is to be treated the same as any other prisoner, and to receive all the food he desires. He declares that Phillips' hunger strike is genuine and that he has not partaken of an ounce of jail fare or any other food. Governor McRobb believes that Phillips, who is very weak, as a result of his fast of thirteen days is about to "cut out" his hunger-strike, as advised by brother-Klanmen. He was asked by Phillips on Monday to let him buy some oranges brought to him by fellow-Klanmen and friends.
