Golden Text.—By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.—Heb. 11: 27.

Exposition.—I. The Burning Bush, 1-3. The time was nearly ripe for Israel's deliverance in three ways: (1) Their sufferings had reached their climax. (2) They were crying for deliverance. (3) The Lord was ready to deliver them.
