Dear 'Old Man'
Your reference to the Stone Church in Eramosa stirred up some memories. In 1869 Mr. James Dabbin (our neighbor in Darlington) moved to a farm in Eramosa, about 5 miles north of Rockwood.

St. Thomas, September 21, 1931.
