PACK EGGS BROAD END UP

Considerable time has been devoted "watery whites" in eggs - a problem which has given rise to much difficulty in the trade and considerable loss to producers, says the report of the Empire Marketing Board. Over a period of two years a number of factors, including the liability of various breeds, to produce "watery whites," the system management, for example, free ranges versus semi-intensive, low versus high feeding, etc., have been examined. None of these factors appear to be responsible, to any appreciable extent for the condition known as "watery white."

In the course of the investigation, eggs twenty-four hours old and packed broad end (air cell) down, had to be sent eighteen miles by road, and they showed on testing a remarkably bigh proportion of "watery whites."
