POTATO HARVEST OF 1933

The preliminary estimate of the total yield of potatoes in Canada in 1933 is 40,280,000 cwt. from 520,800 acres, or 77.0 cwt. per acre, as compared with 78 cwt. per acre in 1932, and 87 cwt. per acre from 574,078 acres, or 83 cwt. per acre, the average for the five years 1927-1931. By provinces the yields in cwt. per acre are, in order, as follows: New Brunswick 120 (80); Quebec 101 (87); British Columbia 100 (118); Prince Edward Island 95 (85); Nova Scotia 85 (103); Manitoba 58 (59); Alberta 55 (68); Saskatchewan 53 (67); Ontario 52 (61).

SELECTING THE LAYING STOCK

It is advisable to start selecting the laying stock just as soon as possible after the pullets are fully feathered out. First of all, select all pullets from your best matings. That is, the pullets selected for laying stock should be from dams that have laid at least 175 eggs averaging 24 ounces per dozen and in either hill, from dams having 200 eggs to their credit, bred by a cockerel whose dam has laid 300 eggs per year with an average of 24 ounces per dozen.

When you have selected all the pullets from your best layers and put them on a separate range, they should be gone over two or three times again before they are placed in their winter quarters. There are three types of pullets usually found in the flock. The first is the clean-cut, deep-bodied, closely-feathered, angular bird that is always alert. The second is the more rounded-bodied, loose-feathered, sluggish bird that fattens readily and very seldom proves to be a profitable egg producer. Then you will generally find a few that are perhaps a combination of the two types just mentioned.

It is well, then, to select the layers from the first type or group, put them on a range by themselves and perhaps go over them once or twice again before they are put into their winter quarters. It is extremely advisable in the interest of economic production to satisfy yourself that the pullets that do not conform fairly closely to the first type previously described. Experience has taught us that the individual that conforms to the egg producing type is one with a deep body, as measured from the front of the breastbone to the centre of the back; a deep gradually tapering flat side, wedge shape; a long, straight back carrying its width well out to the base of the tail. The keel or breast bone should be large and parallel with the back. A good full breast and plenty of width at the pelvis are desirable. Do not overlook the head as it is an excellent index of quality. The head should be clean-cut, medium in length, deep, wide and more or less flat, the width increasing uniformly from beak to a point directly behind the eye. The eye should be large, bright and prominent. A smooth, clear, lean skin over the face is desirable.

The matter of selection is made easier when the birds are of uniform size. Therefore, it is good practice to try to have all hatches come off within a short period as possible. At the experimental farm, New Brunswick, a hatch was found that from April 1 to 15 makes a very suitable period.

Use only good birds, preferably pedigree birds and select carefully the laying stock and you will find that the poultry flock is one of your most profitable sources of farm revenue.

HILLSIDE EROSION

The owner of rolling or hilly land must be constantly on the lookout for new gullies, and must use every means for preventing their enlargement, advises the Dominion Field Husbandman. Shallow ditches which tend to form gullies should be seeded to grass, and kept sodded until such time as the drains become filled with sediment. They may then be cropped but they should be seeded down again if there is the danger of a gully forming. Timothy, red top, and Kentucky blue grass are good grasses for drains. The most elaborate method of preventing erosion is by the use of terraces which are sometimes necessary on steep hillsides where the rainfall is particularly heavy. Terracing is the laying off of the hillside into a series of more or less level ridges or benches at regular intervals from top to the foot of the slope.
