The LETTER BOX

ALBERTA MUNING
Dear Mrs. Pagan:
I have thought to presume, in this, the last opportunity before Christmas, to convey cordial greetings of good-will and best wishes to the Editor and staff, who have so courteously treated this post during the year, and for so long before.

Glad that the Christmas time will have in the home of an old-time friend, that of the late A. E. Nicklin, the eldest daughter, Mrs. Bellwood, of Calgary. We were pleased to notice in the Herald of her departure, by way of her sister's, in Saskatoon, some time ago. I had the pleasure of seeing her last summer, one evening, spraying her lawn, but the necessity of a prompt arrival at home, nearly forty miles to the south, forbade me from pressing to take time for a call.

Among the many reminders of the flight of time is one at my elbow this morning, the Montreal Witness kindly sent to the Misses by someone. One of my early recollections is "The old New Year Day," 1864, being with my grandfather as he finished his regular subscription in the envelope provided. This paper is now ending its thirty-second volume, being established in 1844. It has had three editors all Douglals. I considered it a privilege for old associations sake, to be able to attend, in 1924, the funeral of the second editor, John Redpath Dougal, son of the founder, John Dougal. His term of service as editor was 1870-1924, sixty years. The nature of the service, and the evident character of many of the hosts in attendance, was a tribute to the value of a life devoted to righteous journalism. A natural reflection was of one other who had conducted a weekly in a much smaller community, whose term of life had not been very long closed, but regarding whose work it was testified by one capable of forming a good judgment, "that was always a well-conducted journal, clear and unswerving." Mr. Dougal's portrait hangs in a large frame, about with similar memorials of Past Presidents, along the corridor of the General Y.M.C.A. building in the city of his lifetime.
