LIFE OF CANADIAN BEE

The average life of a bee during the summer months in Canada is approximately six weeks, but in winter their life is prolonged to at least eight months. To do this requires a careful study of colony strength, food supply, and protection in relation to wintering. At one time it was thought that bees could not survive the winter in many parts of Canada unless housed in specially constructed cellars, but the apparatus of the Dominion Experimental Farms have shown that bees can be safely wintered outside in packing cases anywhere in Canada, provided the colonies are properly prepared during the previous fall.

WATER-POWER DEVELOPMENT IN CANADA

Canada occupies an outstanding position among the water-power using countries of the world, according to the Department of Mines and Resources, Ottawa. Hydraulic installations in the Dominion total 8,190,772 horse-power, an average installation of 731 horse-power per 1,000 population. The present turbine installation represents the development of only 18 1/2 per cent. of the recorded water-power resources of the country, which will permit of a turbine installation of about 43,700,000 horse-power. Hydro-power developed from these abundant water-power resources has been a tremendous factor in the entire national development influencing the growth of population, transportation systems, home markets, external trade and national income. Development and distribution of hydro-power has brought to more than sixty per cent. of the population the boon of electricity for light and for many conveniences and labor-saving devices which so greatly ameliorate living conditions to-day. It has penetrated extensively into rural districts bringing to farm dwellers the conveniences and comforts already enjoyed by urban population. Water-power has furnished the low-cost energy so necessary for the economic utilization of other natural resources and the development of basic industries thus enabling Canadian manufactured products to attain a prominent place in world markets.
