The Canadian War Effort

A Weekly Review of Developments Along the Home Front—September 12th-19th

SUMMARY 1. H. H. Winston Churchill called to the Prime Minister of Canada.

2. Wartime Prices and Trade Board given power to "provide safeguards" against "undue enhancement of rentals."

3. Arrangements made to train 22,000 young Canadians in war industries.

4. Announced that increased exports to the United Kingdom have exhausted Canada's big surplus of bacon.

5. Legislation adopted to restrain dealing with or assisting ships calling at Canadian ports or on the high seas not carrying a ship's register license.

6. Organization of the Department of War Services with four main divisions: (a) human resources; (b) material resources; (c) voluntary services; (d) publicity.

7. Proclamation issued, calling single men and childless widowers in the 21 to 24 year classes for 30 days military training for home defence.

8. Dr. Charles Campbell, Deputy Minister of Mines, tours Western Canada in effort to stimulate gold production.
