Turn Mulllets Into Dollars

Manitoba Has Scheme to Make Wartime Asset of Lakes Sucker Fish

WINDYBEE, (CP) - Restrictions which the war has imposed on ocean shipping may prove a boon to Manitoba who annually throw back into Lake Winnipeg, Lake Manitoba and Lake Winnipegosis thousands of mulllets, or sucker fish.

Headquarters of the Industrial Development Board of Manitoba has been working toward the establishment of a plant which would turn the mulllets into a profitable product.

The federal fisheries research board is co-operating fully with industry work at their laboratory and information with respect to the extraction of oil from the fish.

Referring to a recent quick sale of herring oil at Vancouver, Mrs. Phyllis G. Turner, technical adviser on the Wartime Prices and Trade Board at Ottawa, reported that "now there is a good demand for all fish oil which will continue to increase."

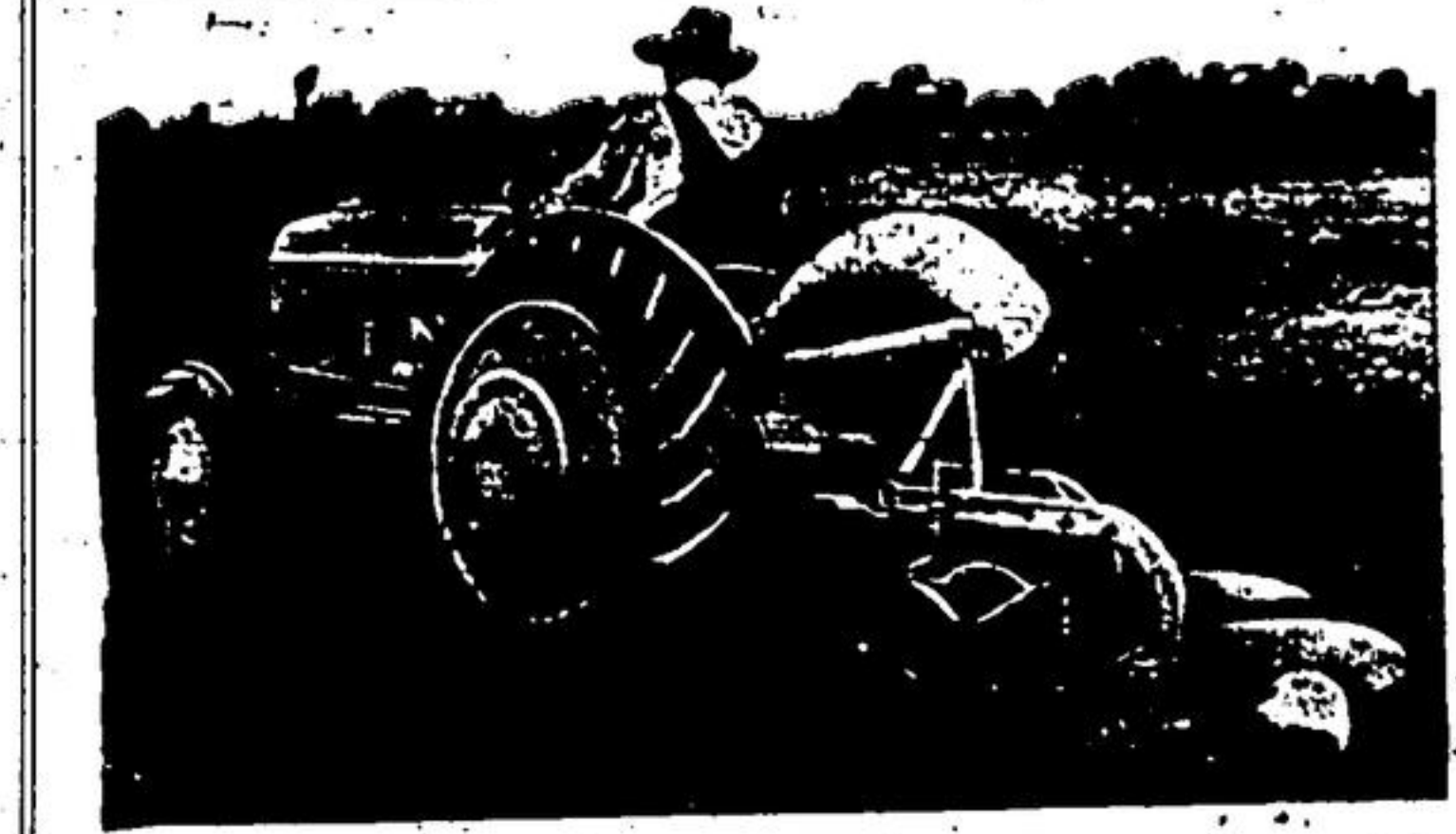
