Chocolate Half and Half

1 or 2 egg yolks
5 cups milk
1/2 cup quick-cooking tapioca
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 or 2 egg whites
1/2 teaspoon flavoring
1/2 cup chocolate sauce

Mix egg yolks with 5 cups milk. Add quick-cooking tapioca, 1/2 cup sugar, salt and remaining milk. Bring mixture quickly to a boil, but over direct heat, stirring constantly. Remove from fire. Mix until it is thick. Do not overcook. Beat egg whites until stiff but not dry, and beat in sugar gradually, beating with rotary or beater. Stir hot tapioca gradually into eggs, while

cool, mixture thickens in a jiffy. When slightly cool, strain into Chiffon cake mold, save some mix of tapioca. This portion can be used as a single, thin, aromatic, pour-over chocolate tapioca cream or may give diagonal effect.

Peach Surprise Sherbet

1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup water
1/2 teaspoon gelatin
2 cups peach juice
1 lemon
2 oranges

Boil sugar and water together for five minutes and add the gelatin, soften in cold water. When the mixture is cold, add the peach juice which has been pressed through a sieve and the juice of lemon and oranges. Freeze.

Corn at Its Best

Can you be considerate like a silly question queen? Of course every widow strives after the job regularly. Who should she think about it?

All right. Do you know how to save to the last drop? Do you have your corn in the right shape and place it in the refrigerator? Do you boil your corn at least twenty minutes? Do you soak it in salted water for a few minutes before boiling it in the table? After you have answered these questions go on to the following perfect directions for a delicious corn.

Boiled Corn

To have the vegetable in perfect form, the husk should be left on until just before it is to be boiled. Plunge the husked ears into boiling water and cook from seven to twelve minutes according to the size of the corn. Do not salt the cooking water as this toughens the corn.

Lay a napkin on the serving plate. Pile the corn upon this in a pyramid, cover it with the corners of the napkin and send it to the table.

"Never use salt in the water in which green corn is boiled. Eat it plain, watered with a touch of sugar instead of salt."

Address Soldiers' Mail In-Ink

Postmaster Theodore William E. Mullock has always shown a keen personal interest in providing safe and expeditious mail to Newfoundland and overseas troops. One frequent sign of duty a dozen miles off the beaten track is his address on many letters.

It has frequently been found that persons writing addresses become smugged and unconcerned, resulting course of transgression with the result that it is very difficult for the Canadian Postmaster to effect delivery.

When INK is used there is less danger of address fading or becoming obliterated and persons' names can help ensure their safe and speedy delivery. By always care taken to see that the address is written in a clear and legible manner in INK.

All mail should be fully prepared and a return address given in the upper left hand corner. Letters, parcels and newspapers for our troops overseas should be addressed to INK as follows:

Regimental Number Rank and Name, Name and Details of Unit or Company, Section, Squadron, Battery, Holding Unit etc., Name of Regiment or Branch of Service, Canadian Army Overseas.

If the soldier is still in Canada, mail should be addressed to him via

Regimental Number, Rank and Name, Name and Details of Unit or Company, Section, Squadron, Battery, Holding Unit etc., Name of Regiment or Branch of Service, Name of the Place in Canada where the Unit is stationed.
