that the war would be won or lost in a year. Your government had no such illusions and planned our war effort for a long struggle...

To sum it all up, the total cost of the last war to Canada, including the cost of demobilization...

Now, what of the future? Our Prime Minister (Mr. Mackenzie King) has already advised us that the navy will be expanded in personnel as rapidly as naval ships can be built.

In the air our enlistments will be maintained to the capacity of our training schools, which are as yet unsurpassed by any country.

Let me illustrate - In my home town of Burlington, with less than 1,000 people, there are seven trucks and seven truck drivers driving up and down the streets...

who are willing and anxious to work for war purposes.

For all of these reasons I would urge that orders should be placed at once which would substantially increase Canada's production of war equipment.

During the first ten months of this fiscal year we have collected nearly \$500,000,000 in income tax, compared with a total of less than \$100,000,000 collected in the entire period of the last war.

In the financing of this war I still have another suggestion to make. We do not hesitate to make a capital levy with respect to the estate of a deceased person.

Right here I should like to make a suggestion in regard to the armed forces. Many of those who have stayed at home have earned good wages. Some have spent them; others would have accumulated savings.

In some communities considerable harm is being done to the war effort through the high wages being paid, especially on piece work, in war-time industries.
