NOTICE EXTRACT FROM BUILDING BY-LAW NO. 781 Dated the 9th February, 1944 SECTION 68—No person shall post or cause to be posted upon any telephone pole, telegraph pole, electric light pole, or other poles established upon the streets of the Village of Acton, any advertising bills, signs or posters, and no person shall throw or permit to fall upon the streets of the said Village of Acton any advertising bills, signs or notices, destroyed or otherwise, nor accumulate or allow to accumulate any rubbish upon said streets.
