FIGHT TO PRESERVE ENGLISH WAR TOWN

HAWTHORN (CP) This Whitshire community of 5,000 is fighting against the prospect of becoming a "ghost town". Five years ago Hawthorn was created from nothing when workers and their families were transported to this uninhabited part of the country to work in a war plant which had been established. Now the war work is finished.

The government offers little hope for the town's future. The Ministry of Labor says "there is plenty of work elsewhere" and lets it go at that. The Board of Trade says it can see no prospect of a peacetime industry being established there.

But the padre, Rev. E. H. Brown, asks: "Why should this young and vigorous community die? Much money has been spent, various developments have been built up, all of which could be turned to good account."

The parish council clerk comments "If these people go away we shall have a derelict area in our midst we cannot understand how the government having spent millions on Hawthorn, is apparently content to let it all go down the drain." He fears Hawthorn may become a distressed area.

- 1. MARKETING BOARDS Assist the farmers to set up Producer Marketing Boards for all major farm products.

8. EDUCATION AND RECREATION Give special attention to rural education and recreation.
9. PACKING PLANTS AND MACHINERY Use to the full the powers of the province to break the packing monopoly and to lower the cost of farm machinery to the farmer.
10. CO-OPERATIVES Give every encouragement to co-operatives, both producer and consumer, and oppose any increase in the taxation of co-operatives.
11. FARM SECURITY The CCF government will pass an act to protect the farmer against the loss of his home and his land from causes beyond his control.

By these means a CCF government will boost farm income, bring the price which the farmer receives for his product into line with what he pays for the goods he buys, and establish conditions on the farm which will encourage the ablest and most forward-looking rural young people to remain in agriculture.
