Compressed Sawdust New Domestic Fuel

FORT WILLIAM, (CP) The answer to an old problem of what to do with the waste sawdust from sawmills has been found in the manufacture of a new form of domestic fuel produced when the sawdust is pressed into the form of small logs.

A new plant at Fort William the first in Canada, has begun production of the material, called Press-to-Log, which is made by subjecting the sawdust to high pressure of 20,000 pounds per square inch in small cylinders or dies.

The pressure breaks down the structure of the sawdust particle, eliminates moisture, and produces a small log, 12 1/2 inches long, four inches in diameter and weighing eight pounds, which is comparable to the weight of rock and coal.

Press-to-log is of much the same composition as coal, which is vegetable, usually trees, subjected to pressure underground for thousands of years. In the case of this new product the method of pressure has been hastened.

Value of Press-to-Log as fuel has been proved by tests made under various conditions in the United States. Among its advantages are that it burns well with a minimum of ash and smoke.

It should particularly appeal to home-owners because a basement stockpile of this fuel can be kept as clean as any other room in the house, and the logs can be handled without soiling the hands.
