Acton Tanners Win 9-5 In Port Dover Series

Second Game in Hespeler Drew A Packed House of 2300 as Two Fine Teams Battled for the O. H. A. Supremacy - Series with Milverton This Week - Acton's Game in Hespeler Again To-night - Now in Semi-Finals for 1948

Intermediate "B" hockey, the caption read, Port Dover Sailors vs. Acton Tanners, Thursday. That undoubtedly was the season's prize understatement.

It was the ice game at its best. Port Dover Sailors, a classy crew with the puck, bowed out of the championship picture with gravity.

The Tanners carrying a one goal lead from the first contest at Brantford, won the Thursday encounter 5-2 when gave them a 9-5 victory on the round.

500 Boards of Trade are Now Association

The number of Boards of Trade and Chambers of Commerce federated in The Canadian Chamber of Commerce has passed the 500 mark for the first time in the history of this national movement.

It is singularly appropriate that the 500th member organization should be the Eastend, Saskatchewan Board of Trade, since it is in many ways typical of the majority of groups in the national movement.

Eastend itself was so named because at one time it was the eastern end of the R.C.M.P. Horse-shoe Patrol from Fort Walsh west of what now is the Alberta border.

With the end of World War II, the leaders in communities all over Canada began to take a renewed interest in public problems, many of which were concerned with the change-over from an active wartime economy to peacetime.

Founded in 1925 at Winnipeg, this national Chamber of Commerce movement has come to represent the country-wide voice of business, small and large, as organized at the "grass roots" or community level.
