**PHOTO ENLARGEMENTS AT NO EXTRA COST**

It may not be so long before all camera fans will be getting post-card size pictures from their small films at the same price as they pay now for their regular snapshots. In fact one large photo finisher in Toronto has already installed the necessary equipment and is turning out the oversize prints for his customers, reports Drug Merchandising.

The new process is known as "strip printing", the druggists' magazine explains. Pictures are printed from the roll film on a single strip of printing paper, perforated so pictures can be separated later. Operating economies and greater speed of the electronically controlled equipment make it possible to provide what would generally be classed as enlargements for the same price as the small snapshots. Negatives from 35 mm. to No. 116 size films produce enlarged prints measuring 3 1/2 by 5 1/2 inches.

It's expected that if and when import restrictions are lifted, more commercial finishing firms will be installing this equipment.
