did not live to see it A Spirit-filled man will be a calm man under any circumstances (2 Tim 1 7) The expression "full of the Holy Spirit" has a different significance from "filled with the Holy Spirit" (Ac 2 4; 4 8, 31) The latter describes the Holy Spirit coming upon one at a definite period of time being with His glorious presence and power; the former describes an abiding condition Being full of the Spirit involved Stephen in inevitable conflict with men who were full of Satan. 
