SUNDAY, JANUARY 22

THE FIRST CHRISTIAN MARTYR Golden Text - Be faithful unto death and I will give you the crown of life. Rev. 2: 10.

Lesson Text - Ac. 6: 8-15; 7: 54-60. Exposition - I. Stephen, the Full Man, 6: 8-15.

The character of Stephen presents a rare combination of strength and beauty, robustness and grace. He was a remarkably full man. "Full of faith" (v. 5); "peace" (v. 6); "power" (v. 8); the Word of God (ch. 7: 3-54); "the Holy Ghost" (6: 5; 7: 55); "love" (7: 60); "courage" (7: 58); "trust" (7: 59). He was also a notable man of prayer (7: 54-60).

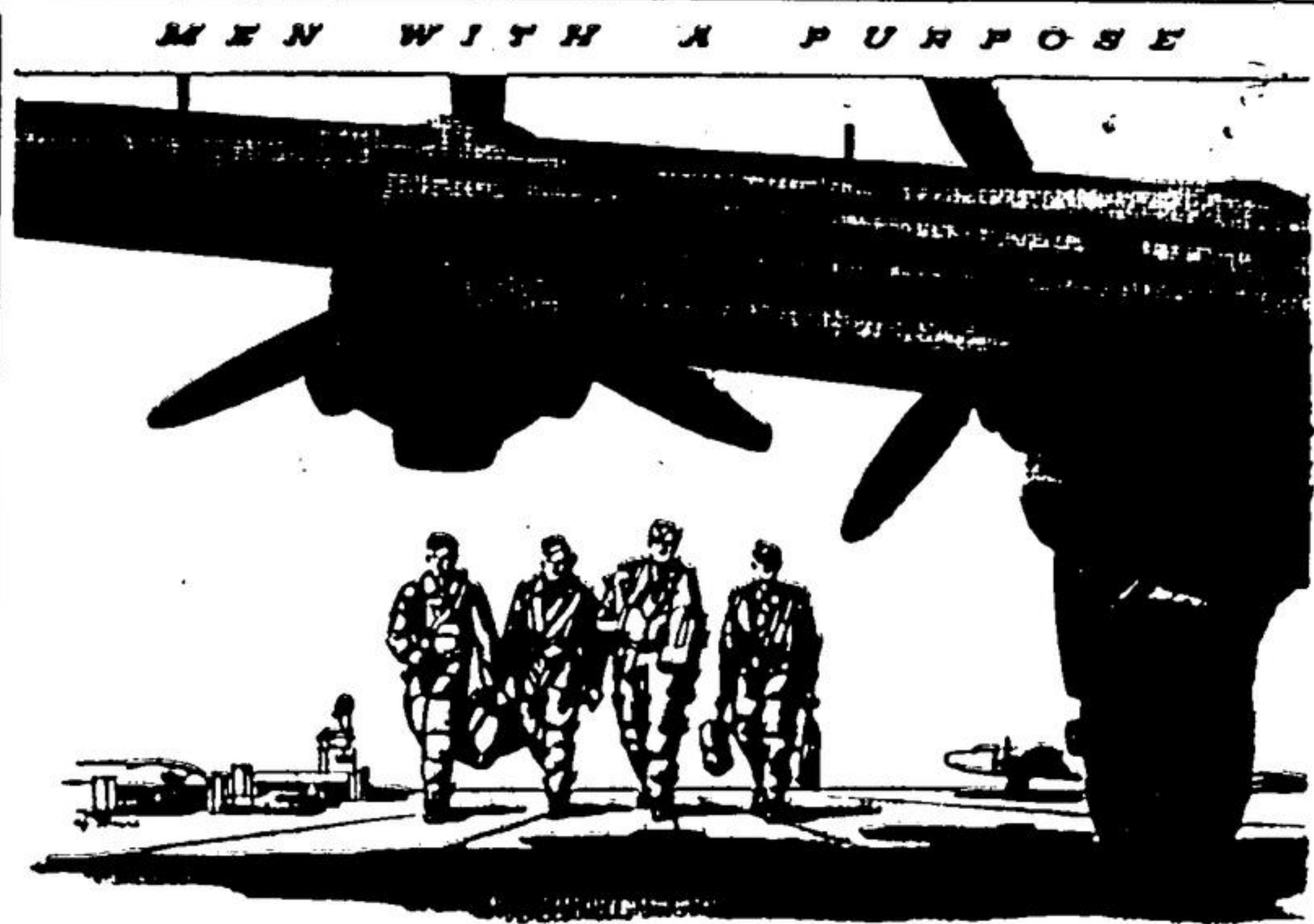
OAKVILLE
