Leson Text -- Ruth 1:8, 14-22. EXPOSITON .- 1. Ruth's Test, 1:

Ruth, the heroine of this lovely Old Testament story, and one of the most brautiful among the wonen-characters of the Bible, was a Machites by birth (ch. 3:6). ghters. The daughters, however, can in turn, transmit it although not colour blind themselves. All colours may be produced

from three, namely red, green, and violet. Three lanterns, one emitting red, one emitting green, and the third violet, would enable us to produce white or any other colour we chose by blending one, two or all three upon a screen.

There are three types of specislized nerve endings in the eye which are affected by colour. One kind of ending is stimulated by red rays, one by green, and the third by violet rays. The colour yellow is due to equal stimulation of red and green and very few violet receptors and in fact every colour may be seen by stimulation of different combinations of receptors.

Very rarely an individual is totally colour blind and this is due to a disorder of all three types of receptors. The person only sees tones of gray. In the common type of colour blindness, not all receptors are affected and usually the subject is blind to red and green, seeing only yellows and blues and blends of these two colours. Such red-green blind individuals see red, orange and green as various tones of yellow, greenblue as bluish gray and purple as blue.
