

those near of kin before we judge as to who should be used in a certain place. Some blame Paul and say that the sequel shows he was mistaken as at a later day he used Mark again (Col. 4: 10). But this is entirely inadequate proof that he was mistaken at this time. Paul's action at this time may have brought Mark to his senses. The whole narrative that follows both in substance and manner justifies Paul. We are told almost curiously that Barnabas took Mark with him and sailed away to Cyprus and that is the last we hear of him. But Paul we are told he went forth being commanded by the brethren to the grace of the Lord. And he went through Syria and Cilicia confirming the churches.

OAKVILLE Pedestrian Killed Struck By Truck

John Shroda, 62, was instantly killed on Monday night when he was hit by a pick up truck on Dundas Street North Driver of the truck, Peter Kroon, with a passenger Harry Homer, both of R.R. 1, were driving north at 11:45 p.m. on their way to work on the second shift at Ferro Enamels.
