. Defrost 'the electric refrigerator when the frost becomes pencil thick. This is usually every two week. Turn on the refrigerator as quickly as possible after cleaning. This saves the motor from working overtime to establish the normal temperature required to keep foods fresh.

2. If a normal temperature is not being maintained as indicated by the use of a refrigerator thermometer (that is 40 degrees in centre of cabinet), then call a serviceman.

When an olly aroma permeates the refrigerator cabinet at time of year it may be due to the fresh oranges of the juicey type. During May and November it is advisable to store oranges and grapefruit along the walls of the cabinet.

i. If the refrigerator dial has not been turned to freezing for at least I hour before trays of Ice cream mix are to be placed in the unit, ice crystals will develop in the dessert. This may be partially prevented by covering trays with foil or waxed paper. By the way, excessive amounts of sugar in the dessert prevent efast freezing and ingredients should be carefully mea-
