Guernsey Breeders Stage Field Day

Saturday of last week was Guernsey day in Milton. It was the occasion of the Guernsey field day, sponsored by the Milton and Peel Club, and was held at Valley Crest Farm, near Palermo. Well over 200 breeders and their families were present. Numbered among the guests were breeders from the York Simcoe Club; the "Big Four" club in Durham, Ontario; Victoria and Peterborough; the Quinte club in Northumberland, Hastings and Edward counties as well as other points in Western Ontario.

Prof. Geo. E. Rathby of the Ontario Agricultural College, was in charge of the judging school held in the morning. Following the lunch an excellent program was run off under the direction of President Arthur Spencer and Vice President John Y. McNabb, of the Milton-Peel Club. This included short addresses by Dr. A. R. Campbell, secretary of the Canadian Guernsey Breeders' Association; Prof. Geo. E. Rathby of the O.A.C.; and agricultural representative J. E. Whitlock; a program of sports for the young folk and a parade of prize winning Clydesdales under Bert Berry, manager of Valley Crest Farms.

In the tug of war event the Milton-Peel team outpulled their fellow breeders from outside points. Despite threatening weather the event was a huge success and reflected much credit on the directorate of the Milton-Peel club and also on the hosts of the day, Mr. and Mrs. Bert Berry of Valley Crest Farms, who had left no stone unturned to make the event an outstanding success.

Check Your Wheat For Hessian Fly

The Hessian Fly some years ago was listed as the most destructive insect attacking wheat in the field. For the past ten or fifteen years it has been a pest of minor importance.

During the past few days we have had two inquiries from Milton growers who were wondering what was causing their wheat to break off just near the ground.

Upon investigation they found what appeared like flax seeds. This is the pupae stage of the Hessian Fly. It is quite possible that the cool weather this spring was favorable for its development. The adult is a small mosquito like fly. The eggs are laid on the leaves and the maggots from these eggs work down between the leaf and the stem. These maggots suck the juice out of these stems and cause a weakened condition, and consequent breakage at or near the ground, and at about this time of year.

The adult flies emerge the latter part of August and in early September and lay their eggs on volu-

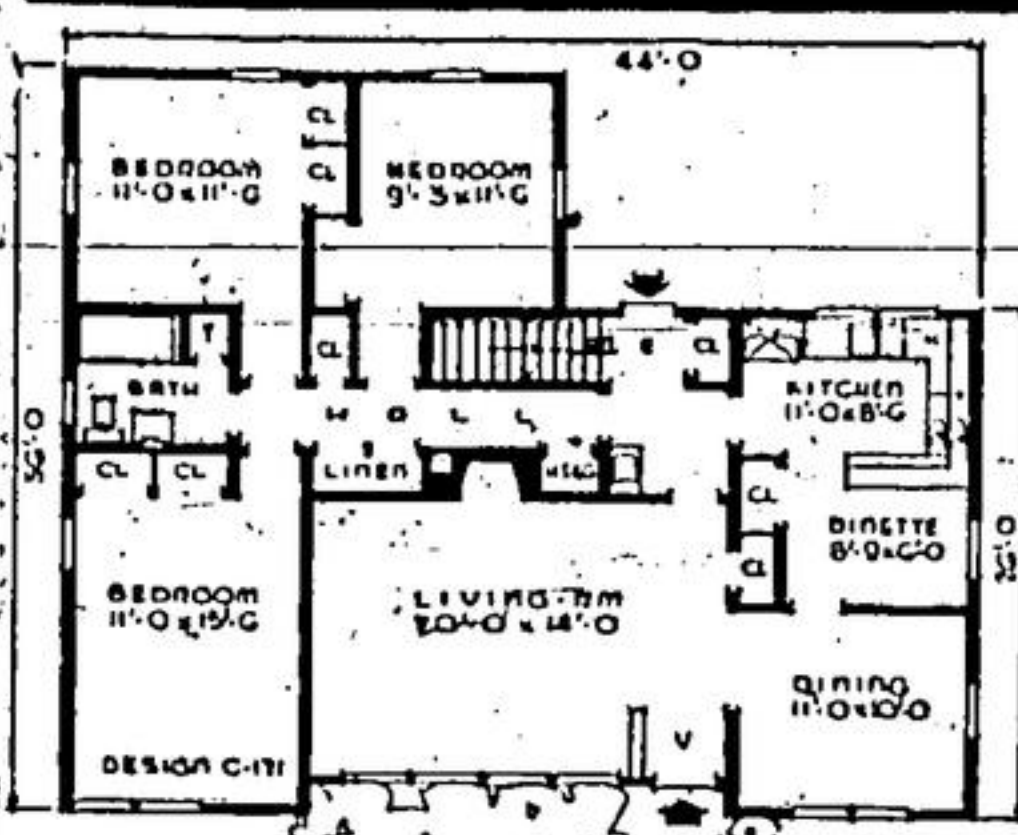

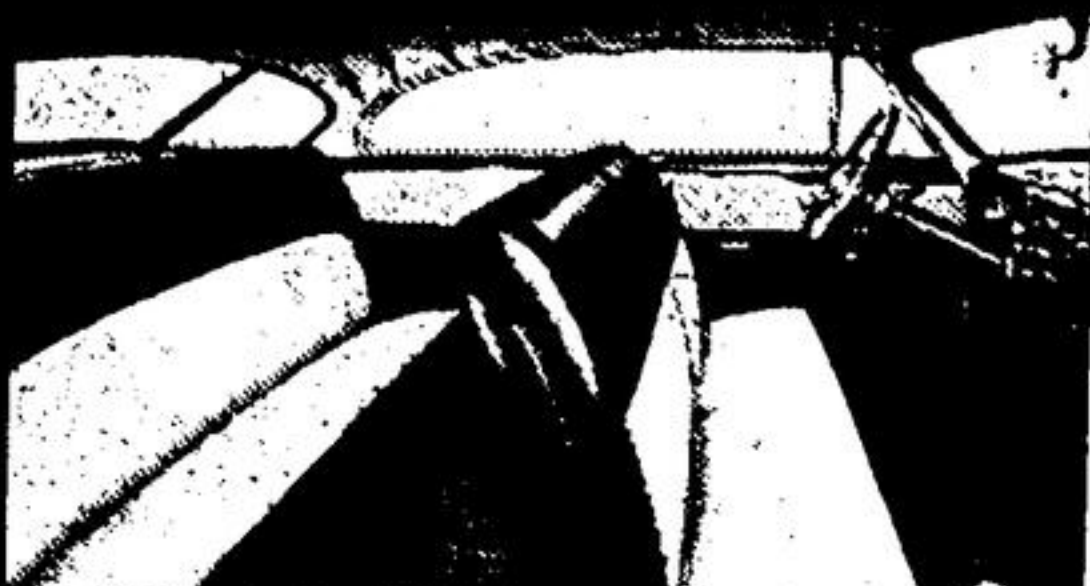

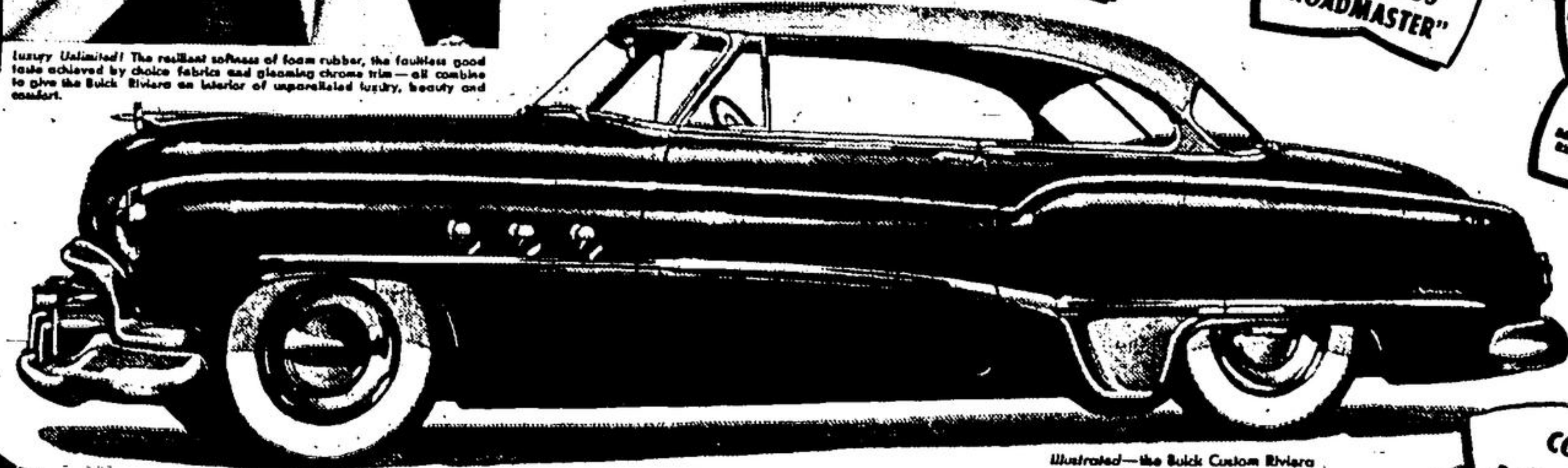
