DON'T FEEL NEGLECTED; YOU'RE ONE OF 44,000 HALTON STATISTICS

Not one soul in this district is insignificant; every single one of us is a pertinent statistic, at least. Latest discoveries following the census are that there were, at the time of the census last June, five people over 95 years of age in Halton county; two of them men and three of them women. There was quite a high figure—41—for the over-ninety and under-ninety-five class and again most of them were women.
 Make a guess how many children there are up to four years of age? Are you so extreme as to guess way up in the thousands? Well, Halton is overrun, figuratively speaking, with children just learning to walk. There are 5,367 of them in Nelson, Esqueness, Trafalgar and Nassagaweya. There are almost 100 more boys than girls, too.
 All the way through the age groups there are more men around than women until the age of 69, and then endurance shows and the women begin to outnumber the men as figures steadily dwindle.
 The second largest age group in the county following the toddlers is the five to nine bunch. Maybe there's a lost tribe there who are scared to death by school—anyway, the next largest age grouping isn't the 10 to 14's as might be expected but the 35-39 age group. So maybe there's something behind the encouraging old saying, "life begins at 40." The next largest group, with a bustling 3,497, is the roaring late twenties.
 And these roaring twenties are the ones who dance to the hit parade with the sound of wedding bells in their ears. Roar away, you twenties gals! There are ten thousand and some unmarried males in this wonderful county and only nine thousand-odd gals. Of course, some of these men are still in rompers, but they'll grow up soon.
 The old riddle, "What percentage of married people in the world are men?" answer: 50 per cent., ha-ha! is blasted by the government, which is often rebuked for its lack of humor. In Halton there are 11,170 married men but only 11,169 married women.
 Think you can solve that? Nope—widows and widowers and divorced people are listed separately! So just try to figure it out, if you can. In the county there are 616 widowers and 1,405 widows—the female outnumbering is really high here.
 And there are quite a few more divorced women than men—47 women and 29 men.
 Four good ways to save gasoline are recommended by engineers: time your driving to the setting of traffic lights to avoid starts and stops; avoid high speed, especially on the open highway; keep spark plugs cleaned and properly gapped; and maintain proper tire inflation.

- 1 lb. mince-meat (about 1 1/2 cups)
 2 cups minced apples
 1/2 tsp. grated lemon rind
 1/2 tsp. grated orange rind
 1/2 cup sugar
 1/2 cup browned almonds
 Plain pastry for double crust
 Prepare pastry and line 9-inch pan. Mix ingredients for filling except nuts. Spread filling on pastry. Sprinkle with toasted halved nuts. Cover with top pastry which has been patterned so that steam escapes readily. Bake at 450 degs. for 12 mins., then reduce to 350 degs. for about 20 mins.
 Pie may be made 2 or 3 days ahead and warmed before serving time. Takes about 1/2 hour in warming oven.
- Sausage Stuffing**
 (for medium turkey or 2 chickens)
 8 cups soft crumbs
 1 cup minced onions
 1 cup minced apple
 1/2 cup minced celery
 1/2 lb. sausage meat
 1/2 tsp. sage
 1/2 tsp. thyme
 1/2 cup butter
 1 egg
- Pan fry the sausage, separating pieces as much as possible. Lift out sausage and brown onion, and celery. Meanwhile prepare crumbs and add butter, egg and seasonings. Then add sausage, and remaining ingredients. (If you wish to slice stuffing, add a little hot water.)
