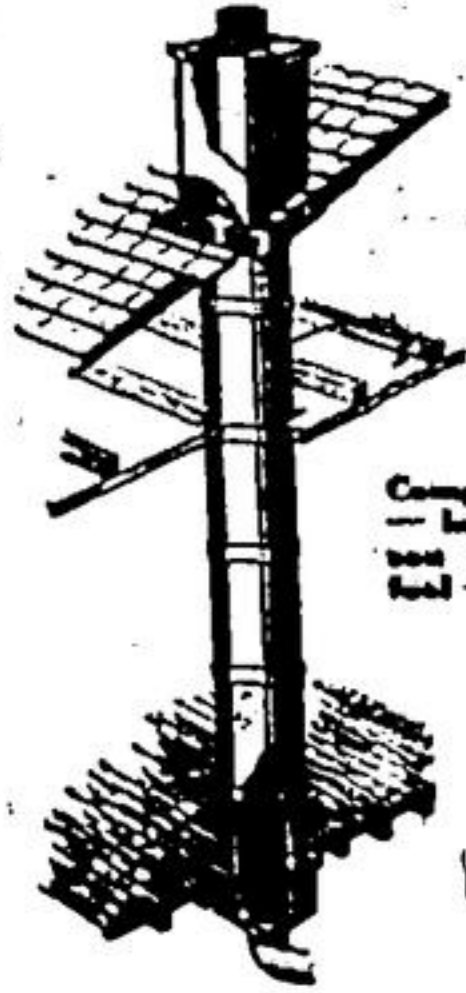

### Set Nomination, Election Dates

The date, place and officials for nominations and elections were decided when Erin township council met on October 6 at Hillsburgh with reeve, Albert Wheeler presiding.

The by-law was passed setting a date and naming a place for the holding of the nomination for a reeve, deputy reeve and three councillors for 1953, for the nomination of three trustees for school area No. 1 and three trustees for school area No. 2 to hold office for two years, for setting the date and appointing officials for the election and setting the time for the opening and closing of polls on election day.

Nominations are to be held in the town hall, Hillsburgh, on Friday, November 21 and the election will be held on Monday, December 1.

T. Lacey, D.R.O., Thos. Keenan P.C.; No. 7 Leslie's School at No. 8 Schoolhouse, Chas. McKeown D.R.O., Thomas McCutcheon, P.C.

A by-law imposing an additional charge on all taxes unpaid by Dec. 15, 1952, was passed.

Council decided that all taxes will be due and payable on Dec. 15.

Overdue taxes will be charged a penalty of one-half of one per cent, per month or fraction thereof for the balance of the current year.

On and after January 1953 the statutory penalty of one-half of one per cent, or fraction thereof will be charged until paid.

#### LONELIEST GIRL IN THE WORLD

Another mystery story—but has anyone ever heard of a mystery yet in which the lovely girl has brilliant pink hair—"bassinet pink"—and one of the main characters is a talking machine?

The "loneliest girl in the world" lives in a penthouse on the 37th floor of a big New York hotel—all alone, except for a room full of machinery that had a kind of soul of its own and is shock full of tell-tale evidence, tucked away on recordings that would take 50 years to hear.

Hidden in the machine was the secret which quite a few wanted to know.

A novel of suspense, "The Loneliest Girl in the World" is extra entertaining because of the novel twists like the bright pink hair. There are some altogether entrancing sentences here and there like "the sky was a pasture of sleeping white lambs." Another trick is having different characters in charge of different parts of the story, telling their own side of the business.

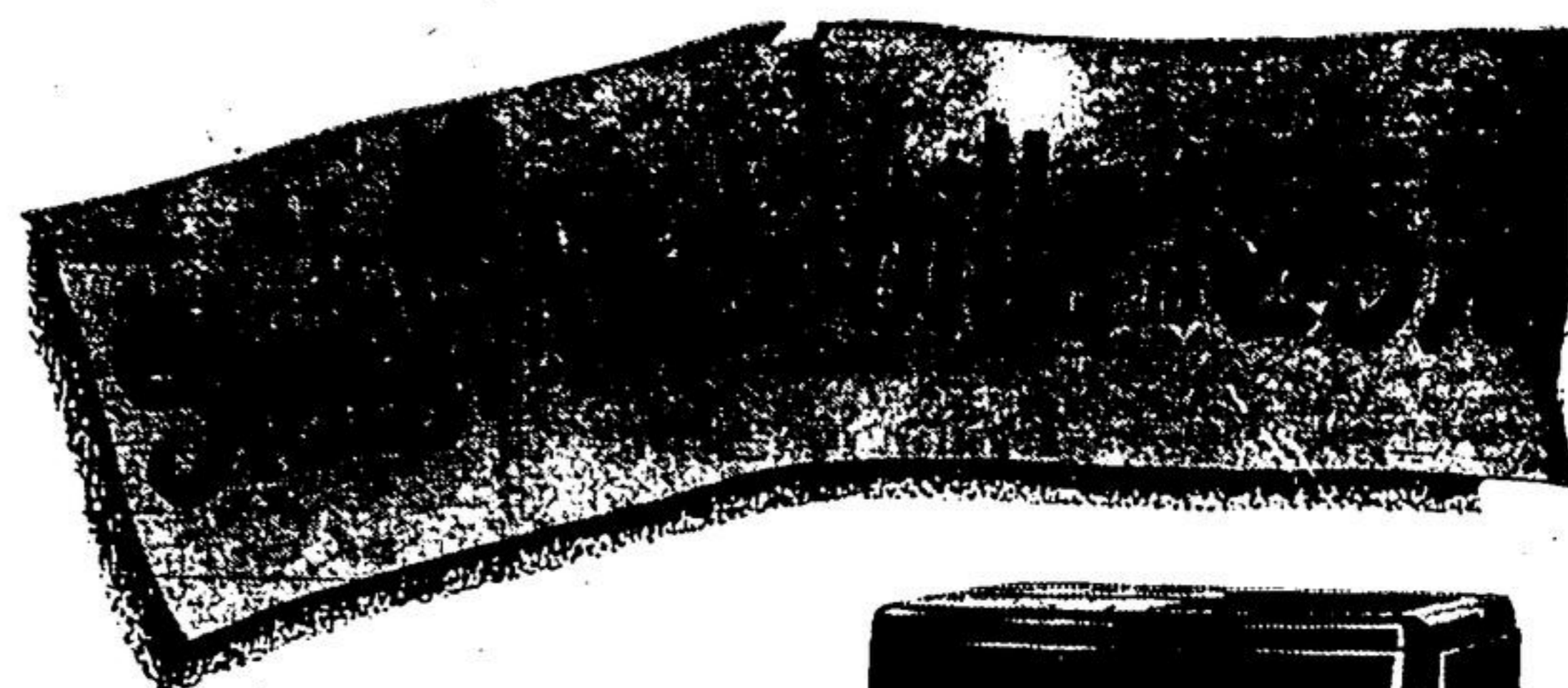
