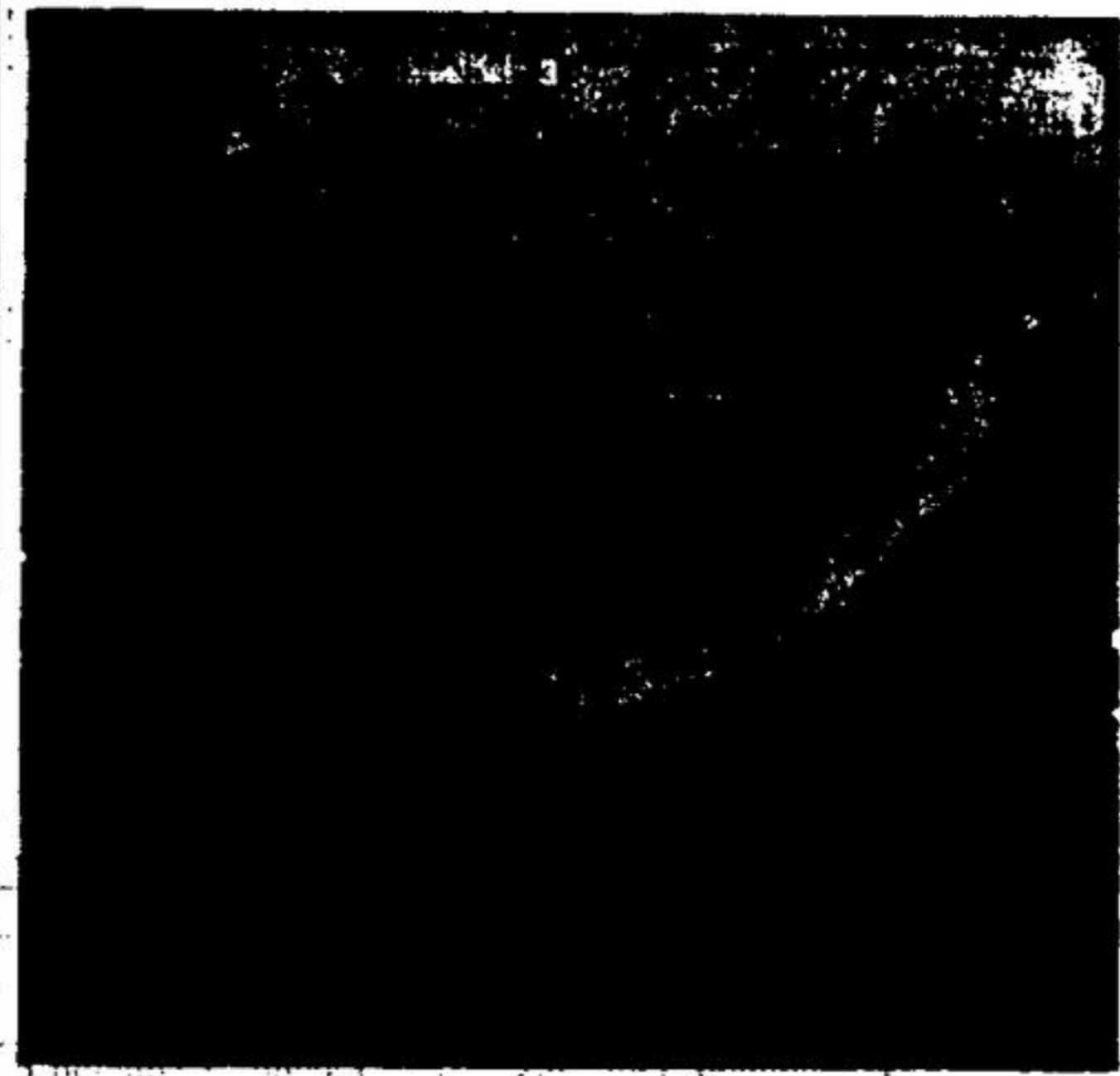

## Canadian Mint Is Making a Mint

Coin production in Canada's Mint can't keep up with demand, the Financial Post reports. The Mint's annual production hovered around 30 million coins until 1940. Since then, it has more than tripled, with an average output of 100 million coins a year.

The Mint has to plan ahead to face regional demands. For example, "nickels" were a big item in Toronto for the Canadian National Exhibition. When Vancouver street car fares hit a straight 10c rate, extra "dimes" had to be provided for the city. The jump of most Canadian daily newspapers to 5c meant more demand for "nickels."

This year, the new 50c pieces with the Queen's effigy are getting a big play. Switch by Bell Telephone to the 10c pay phone rate resulted in a run on "dimes." Another currently bullish factor on coin consumption is the increasing popularity of vending machines.

Incidentally for movie fans also included in the selections of Somerset Maugham's short stories is "Rain" which I believe Rita Hayworth is shortly to enliven on the screen. 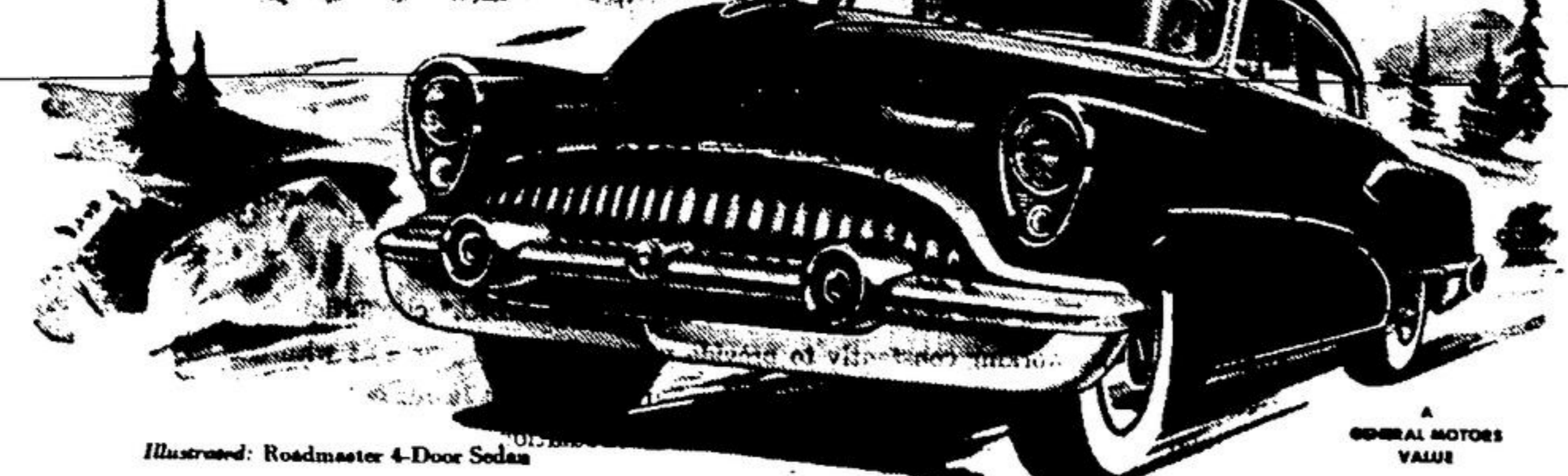
driving was limited to one headlight. Perhaps some of our readers can give us more information on this old picture.
