"Is there a fair and simple formula for sharing expenses on a car trip?"
Depending on the number of persons making the trip, I recommend one of the following plans, as fair to both car owner and passengers:

(1) If the car owner and only one other person are making the trip, all costs should be divided on a simple 50-50 basis.

(2) With the owner and two passengers making a trip, the transportation cost per person drops and it is fair that the two passengers divide the gasoline and oil expenses while all three share other normal expenses.

(3) With the owner and three or more passengers, the cost per person drops even more and the passengers should bear all gasoline, oil, garage expenses and, in addition, should contribute towards wear and tear on the car.

A simple and fool-proof method of handling money on a share-the-cost plan is for each person to contribute an amount into a purse which is used for expenses to be shared. Such a plan eliminates the inevitable confusion and awkwardness of each person figuring and paying for every purchase.

Nitrogen Seen Key To Food Supplies

With population steadily rising and expansion of crop lands almost reaching its limit, we will have to increase food production on land now available, says the Reader's Digest. Otherwise, our present high protein meat diet cannot be maintained.

One of the most important elements in producing more food on our farms is nitrogen. A colorless, odorless gas which makes up about 80 per cent. of the earth's atmosphere, nitrogen is essential to both animal and plant life yet it is the one element most generally lacking in sufficient quantity, in the soil. Natural forces have been "fixing" nitrogen that is combining it with other elements in the atmosphere, such as oxygen and hydrogen and depositing it in the earth almost since the beginning of time. But our crops are using it up faster than nature can replace it.

ation with waste matter, a 12 cent pound of nitrogen may produce an extra 30 pounds of grain. In Illinois, where the average farm produces just over 50 bushels of corn per acre, a farmer who used generous quantities of nitrogen and waste matter has averaged 117 bushels to the acre for the past five years.

Not only has nitrogen accounted for tremendous increases in farm production, the Digest article adds but it has also been successfully combined with such waste matter as corn cobs, corn stalks and straw to provide an inexpensive and nutritious feed for cattle. This type of cattle feed called "one of the most insignificant developments since man first domesticated animals," could mean that thousands of tons of linseed cottonseed and soybean meal formerly used for feeding cattle will be made available to hogs and poultry, with a resultant increase in our national production of meat for the dinner table.

Now modern chemists have learned how to "fix" nitrogen synthetically at low cost and a solution to the problem is in sight. Properly applied to the soil in combin-

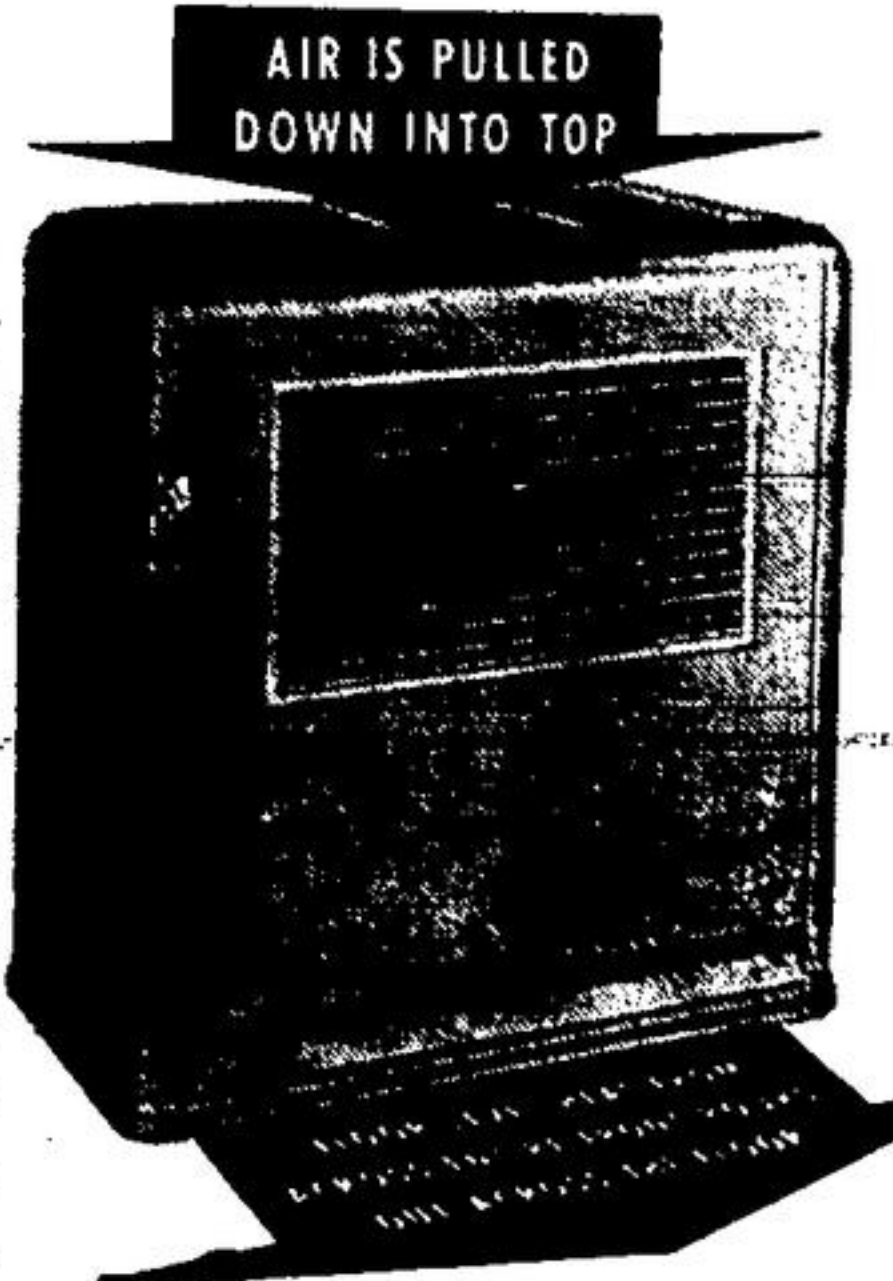
