OBITUARY

Has Heart Seizure During Rainstorm

Saturday, July 31 saw the sudden passing of Henry Sayers, R.R. 1, Acton, a respected farmer of Nassagaweya township. Mr. Sayers had enjoyed good health until then and was in his 77th year.

Saturday afternoon he went out to look for some cattle. While away an electrical storm came up and when he failed to return, his wife, daughter and son-in-law went out to search for him. While hurrying to get out of the rain he suffered a heart seizure and they found him with his faithful Collie dog watching over him. A quiet, retiring man, fond of reading and music, he in his younger days played the violin. He was honest in character and a good neighbor. A devoted husband and kind father, he leaves to mourn his loss his wife, the former Jane Waldie, and two sons, James, R.R. 4, Acton; Earl, Oshawa; two daughters, Mrs. Ward Bruce (Flora), Osprey; Mrs. Gordon Johnston (Jean), R.R. 1, Acton; seven grandchildren; two sisters, Mrs. D. Waldie, R.R. 4, Acton and Mrs. A. Zimmerman, Neepawa, Man. Two brothers predeceased him, Charles some years ago and William Sayers of Pricerville, on July 7 of this year, as the result of a fall from a load of hay.

Mr. Sayers was the son of the late James Sayers and Naomi Trotter and was born in Waldemar, Ont., Amaranth township, Wellington county on August 21, 1877. At an early age he moved to Speyside where he attended Dufferin school. Esquering. His parents then moved to the homestead in Nassagaweya township and he attended No. 7 School, Nassagaweya. In his teens he worked with his father clearing the land, using the old method of cutting the grain with cradle and binding by hand, seeing a great many changes in farming methods in his lifetime.

On December 26, 1907, he married Jane Waldie and moved to the present farm, where he has resided for the past 47 years.

The funeral was held August 3 from the Victor Rumley and Son funeral home, Acton. He was an adherent of Acton Presbyterian church and Rev. R. H. Armstrong, Acton, conducted the service, assisted by two nephews, Rev. Willis Sayers, Meaford, and Rev. John Waldie, London, Ont. Pallbearers were friends and neighbors, Errol Sprawl, A. Interment was in Fairview cemetery, Acton, Ont.

Secretary Accepts College Position

Dick Schull, who for the past year has been general secretary of the Acton Y.M.C.A., has tendered his resignation and accepted a position in his native Holland. After living in Canada for a year and 12 days, Mr. and Mrs. Schull and their three children, Dietrich, Rodrik and Albertine will sail from Quebec on the ship John A. van Oldenbarneveldt on August 16.



They arrived in Acton August 16 last year and, highly recommended, Mr. Schull assumed the duties of general secretary of the Y here.

On his return to Holland, he will become the director of physical education in the Dutch Training College for Service in Foreign Countries. Students at the college will be future executives, diplomats and ambassadors. The college which accommodates from 200 to 300, is located in a fourteenth century castle near Amsterdam in Breukelen which Mr. Schull explains is the same word as Brooklyn. Mr. Schull will remain in the Y as a layman. He is a member of three committees of the World's Alliance.

He will be the director of Physical Education at the Y.M.C.A. Centennial at Paris in August, 1955. Expected to be there are 10,000 participants, spread over 20 miles in the city. About 400 Canadians will attend the centennial celebrations.
