Streetsville Dial Telephone Building Property Purchased

Purchase of property to be used for the construction of a dial telephone building in Streetsville was announced last week by W. O. Misener, Bell Telephone manager for that area.

Mr. Misener said that construction of a building on the site will get under way soon. It will be designed to conform with its surroundings in the village.

"When it is erected, the long and complex job of installing dial switching equipment and associated apparatus will get under way, and will be ready for use late in 1956, at which time all telephones in the exchange area will be changed over to the new system of operation."

Chamber Endorses Burlington Ward Vote

A motion favoring a referendum for re-dividing Burlington's ward system and electing councillors by wards received the endorsement of the directors of the Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber felt the new system would provide better over-all representation.

Doug Woolley, president, presided and a general discussion of civic affairs followed the routine business.

Georgetown Council Against Other Building By-Law Infractions

Allowing another infraction of the five foot limit which a house was required to be from the side property line was reduced to four feet and it is still being abused.

Cr. Sargent agreed with the reeve but said he couldn't see how council could fine a builder and approve a contravention at the same time.

"It might be better to have a few foundations torn down to show we mean business," said Mr. Sargent.

Mayor Armstrong pointed out that the fine limit is \$50, and a magistrate might not impose this maximum. It might pay a subdivider to deliberately break the by-law and pay a \$50 fine, he said.

Mr. Tower, representative of a Toronto law firm, explained that some houses have been found to be 3.97 feet from the sideline instead of 4 feet, while others are closer to the street line than they should be.

The houses are almost built and deputy-reeve Allan Norton expressed a majority council opinion when he said he didn't like it but couldn't see what else could be done.

"On three occasions we've done the same for other contractors and this time I'll agree to an infraction," said Mr. Norton.

Reeve Stan Allen and Cr. Doug Sargent opposed any more concessions, arguing that contractors will continue to break by-laws unless council gets tough.

"If houses are started, we can't have them torn down," said the reeve, "but we can fine them so they won't do it again."

Held Many Jobs In Far-Off Asia

North Vancouver, B.C. (CP) — After a diversified career in the entertainment and business world, Mrs. Leslie Kok has settled down to operating a dog biscuit factory here.

During 20 years of travelling throughout the world she turned with apparent ease from one interesting occupation to another.

A native of Vernon, B.C. she went to school in England and journeyed to the Far East as the wife of aviator Adam Richardson.

After he died in a plane crash, she set up business as an expert in the care of horses and dogs.

Unexpected Summer Arrivals Cause Big School Headache

A goodly number of unexpected arrivals in Burlington during the summer months upset calculations of the needs of the high school and the board was forced to hire another general teacher for grade nine.

In his report to the board, the principal stated that in the present organization, the board had allowed for eight grade nine classes.

"However," the report went on, "if we were to hire another teacher and open an additional classroom, we could re-divide our grade nines into nine classes, with an average enrolment of 38."

The enrolment figures showed an attendance at that period of 860, compared to 685 which was the highest enrolment ever reached during the previous school year. With marked increases in all grades the greatest increase came in the grade nine classes where there are 343 students. There are 79 students writing their final exams this year.

Also presented to the meeting was a petition signed by a majority of the local businessmen stating that an agent was "needed, required and requested" at the Bronte station.
