Newfoundland Unit Selects Own March

GRAND FALLS, Nfld. (CP)—The old song, "The Banks of Newfoundland," has been named the official regimental march of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment. It was announced by Lt.-Col. W. B. Tucker, commanding officer.

It was originally composed as a dance tune by Sir Francis Forbes, chief justice of Newfoundland from 1816 to 1822. Legend says he composed it on a ship that was becalmed in fog on the Grand Banks. It was played by an Irish piper in 1790 at St. Patrick's Day dinner of the Irish Benevolent Society.

The march is without words although there have been attempts to write verses for it. The Royal Newfoundland Regiment did not participate as a unit in the Second World War and is now part of the Canadian militia.
