### P.U.C. Seeks Full Time Meter Reader Review Problems in Present Method

Meter reading problems were the main issue at the meeting of the Acton Public Utilities Commission Thursday. The discussion led to a decision to advertise for a full-time meter reader for the Commission. The secretary noted the number of back calls or guesstimates that result when people are not home and any access is denied. It was explained when the meter is finally read it often results in abnormally high bills. One superintendent reported a meter reader had been expelled from a house even after knocking, calling and entering only a landing to read the meter. The meter reader being sought would work out of the commission office where the records are kept and have other duties as well, members agreed. Bill Morrison complained of a low, then high hydro bill, despite regular readings. He noted his former bill was \$8.64 and his current bill \$29.81. Members reviewed the past bills and suggested it averaged out alright but were unable to explain the great variation. Mr. Morrison pointed out he had reported the low bill and given officials an opportunity to make any corrections but had been assured it was satisfactory. A parallel meter to be installed to check the present meter and the bill was to stand in the meantime. Superintendent Mason reviewed other abnormally high bills in one building where access to meters was not often possible. The consumers were to be notified and parallel meters to be installed to check the existing meters. Difficulty with access to meters in a Bower Ave residence was noted. It was explained they could not be read without crawling through water. The property committee and the superintendent were to investigate the situation. Approval was received from the H.E.P.C. for the installation of a three phase power line on Church Hill Road to serve the new well site. The H.E.P.C. agreed it would be un-

economical to serve the site from the rural lines. The wage structure, the need for any further permanent hydro employees and a holiday policy of one week for the first five years and two weeks after that were discussed and approved. The superintendent's reports noted completion of mercury vapor street light installation, arrangements for changing a power installation to Micro Plastics; the expected arrival of the contractors to paint the water tower, the plan for painting of hydrants, the progress of sewer flushing and the planting of trees at the disposal plant site. Purchase of a power mower for the sewer and waterworks department was approved. Following discussion on the appearance of sewer tile from the stock pile, with town workers using it for driveway tile, the Commission approved a resolution that the works department of the town is not permitted to use supplies from the Commission without the approval of the superintendent involved. Superintendents were instructed to obtain all their gas and oil supplies from Grant Motors until further notice.
