## Council Approves \$87,640.99 Tender For Glenlea Storm Sewer, Paving Project

Council accepted the tender of Gordon Contractors of Toronto for the storm sewer installation and paving of the Gordon area which has been held over from the previous year. The tender price of \$87,640.99, open the recommendation of the roads committee Monday night.

The tender submitted for study by the roads committee ranged from the accepted price of \$87,640.99 to the high of \$102,000.00, as indicated by the committee report.

Before final approval was given, councillor B. D. McLeod asked what portion of the project was payable for town and county road. Mr. Garrow explained that approximately \$10,000 would be the town's portion of the cost with the balance being taken care of by the county.
