

Accuse Firm Of Pollution

The Ontario Water Resources Commission charged a Hamilton firm with polluting the waters last week.

On a complaint by engineer John W. Barr, Niagara Food Products Ltd., located off the Queen Elizabeth Way near the Blouney Creek traffic circle, has been charged as follows:

... did unlawfully discharge material in a place, to wit the property in and about Niagara Food Products Ltd. in the City of Hamilton, under circumstances that the quality of the water known as Blouney Creek, may be impaired thereby, contrary to Section 27 Subsection One of the Ontario Water Resources Act Statutes in Origin, 1957, and all relevant amendments thereto.

The hearing on the charge will take place before a Hamilton magistrate on Jan. 20.

Mr. Barr is the son of E. F. Barr of Acton.

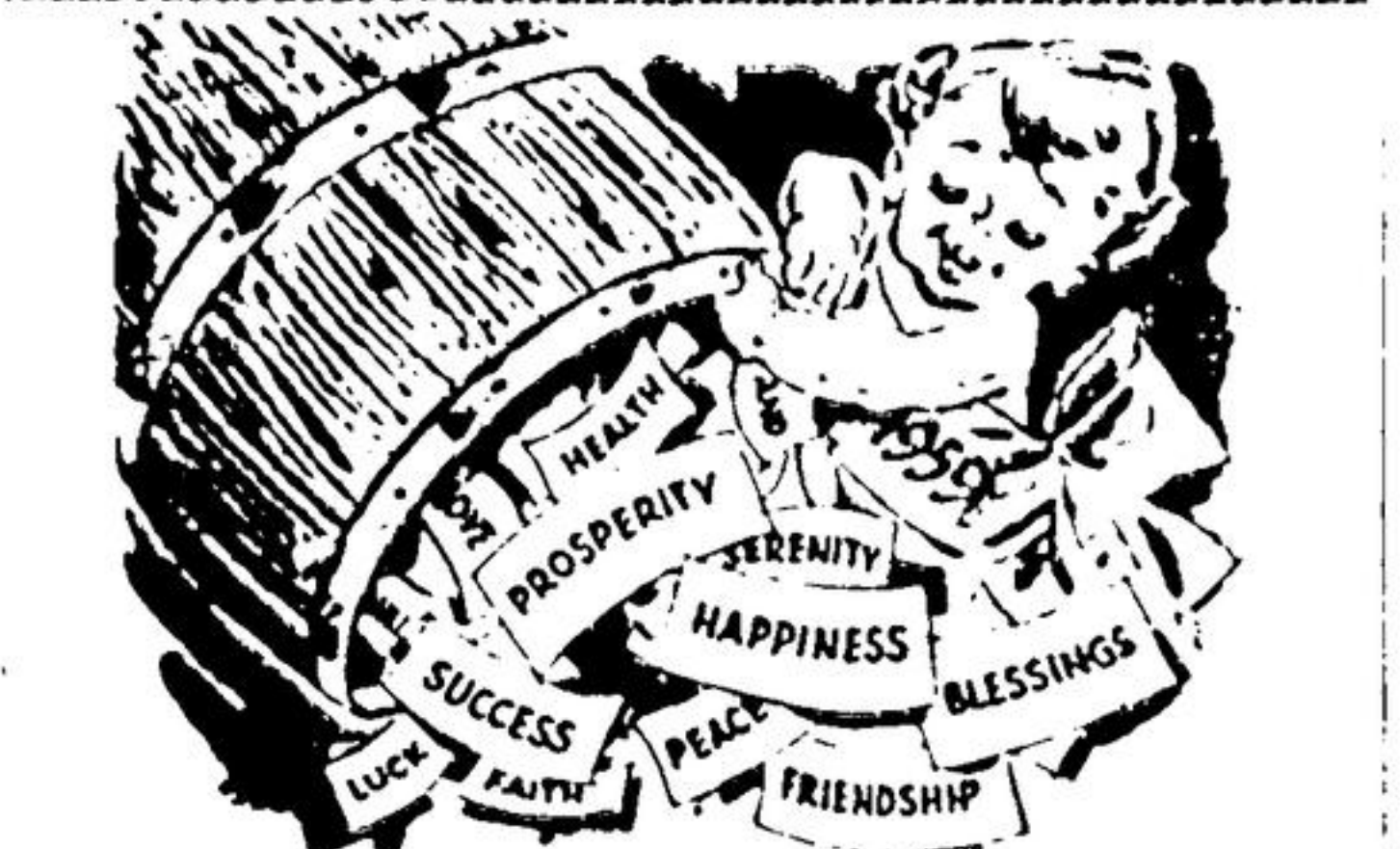
