

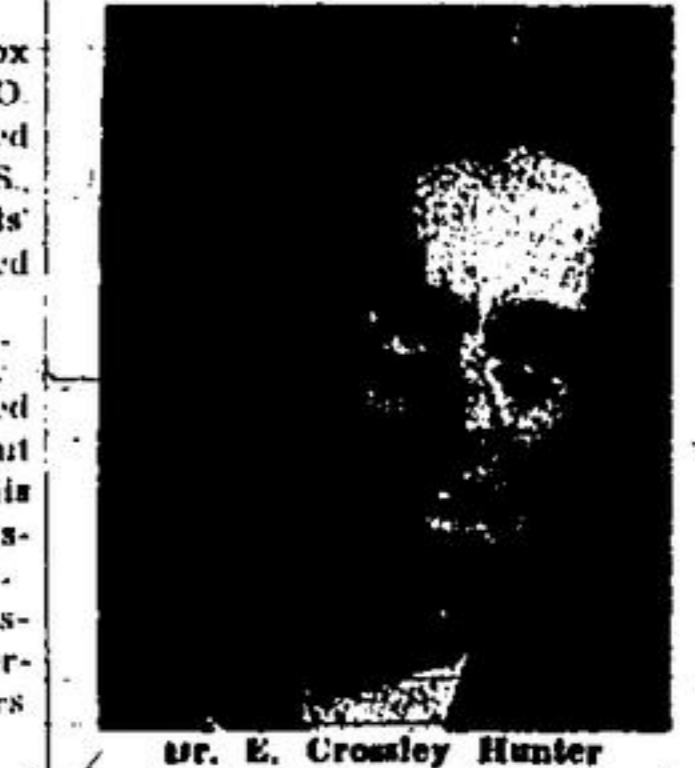
Dr. Crossley Hunter to Conclude Apt Holy Week Sermons Tonight

Senior Auxiliary and Knox Alert Auxiliary. Members of the St. John Ambulance brigade were on duty at all services.

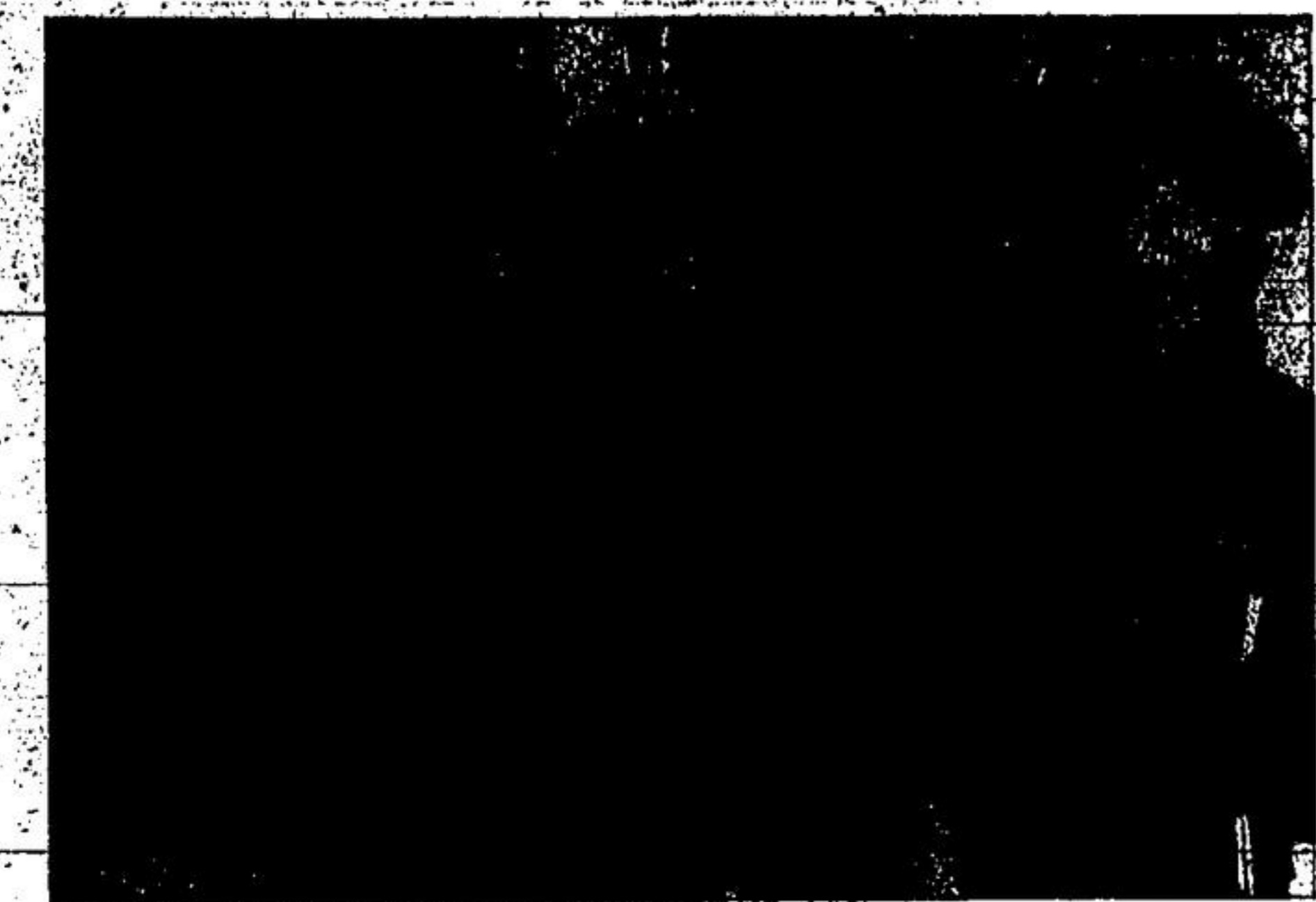
