The later French Christmas were marked from the British and the French.

Themselves did not celebrate Christmas at all for they looked down upon it as a Pagan festival handed down from Roman times.

It is said that Saint Nicholas, the German saint, in the 10th century, where he was born, Prince Albert, introduced the custom of Santa Claus.

British immigrants celebrated Christmas with an enormous dinner of fowl, beet, plum pudding and mince pie. The native Americans, who had been influenced by an earlier French stage, for presents were not exchanged until New Year's Day (the Feast of the Epiphany).
