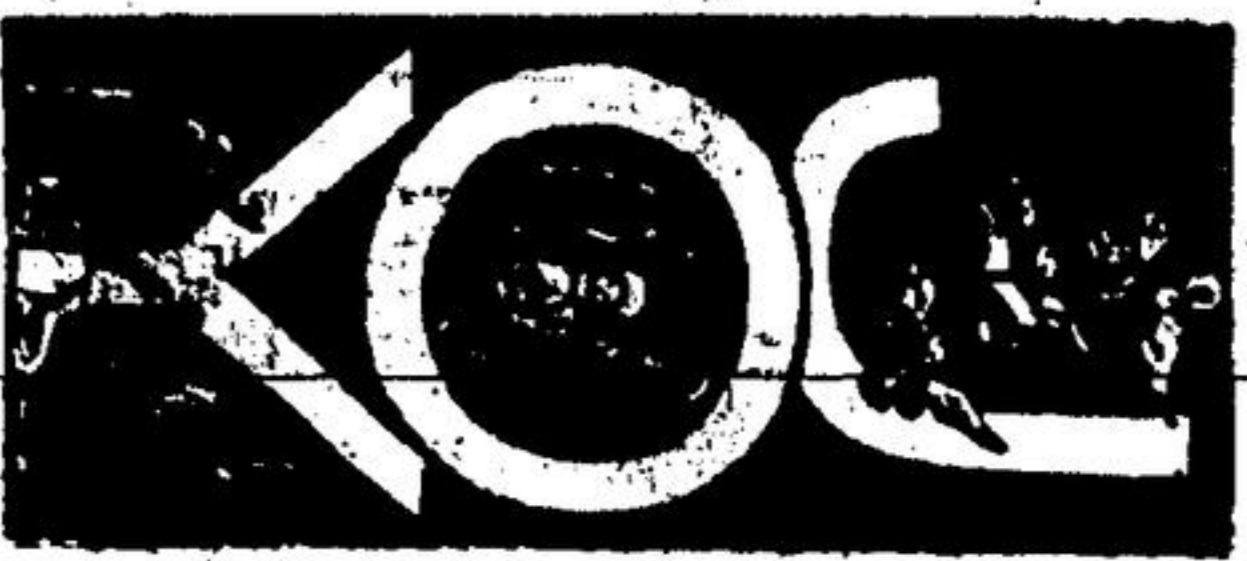


Poinsettia Blossom Not Red But Yellow

This year the Lutheran Home would tell millions throughout the world the real Christmas story and significance of the Christmas story in two years. As the first of the year, more than 100 Lutheran stations will carry the Christmas story in their own languages. In addition, 155 countries in addition, a special Christmas program will be carried on many stations and networks. The Lutheran Home will be introduced in America by German Lutheran immigrants in festive birth celebrations.

In past years these Christmas special programs have been carried on the radio and television. These special programs have a tremendous potential audience, including oppressed Christians, behind the Iron Curtain and people who might never hear of the Christ-child in any other way. Last year's special program "Christmas in the Heart" was the most extensive night broadcast ever made.

Many of the customs we observe from Christmas time to the New Year are of pagan origin. In the past, the sun was worshipped. Since their lives and livelihood depended on the sun, they held elaborate ceremonies to their sun gods at the winter solstice.

In the month the sun goes weak and the winter is at its darkest. The sun is worshipped to bring the sun back to life. The idea of the sun's return in early winter was used with Christ's coming as the Light of the world.

The Druids worshipped the mistletoe and hung it in their homes. The Romans used holly, holly, green holly, and holly leaves to decorate around the celebration of Christ's birthday. Burning the yule log in England and giving candles became part of the Christmas story.

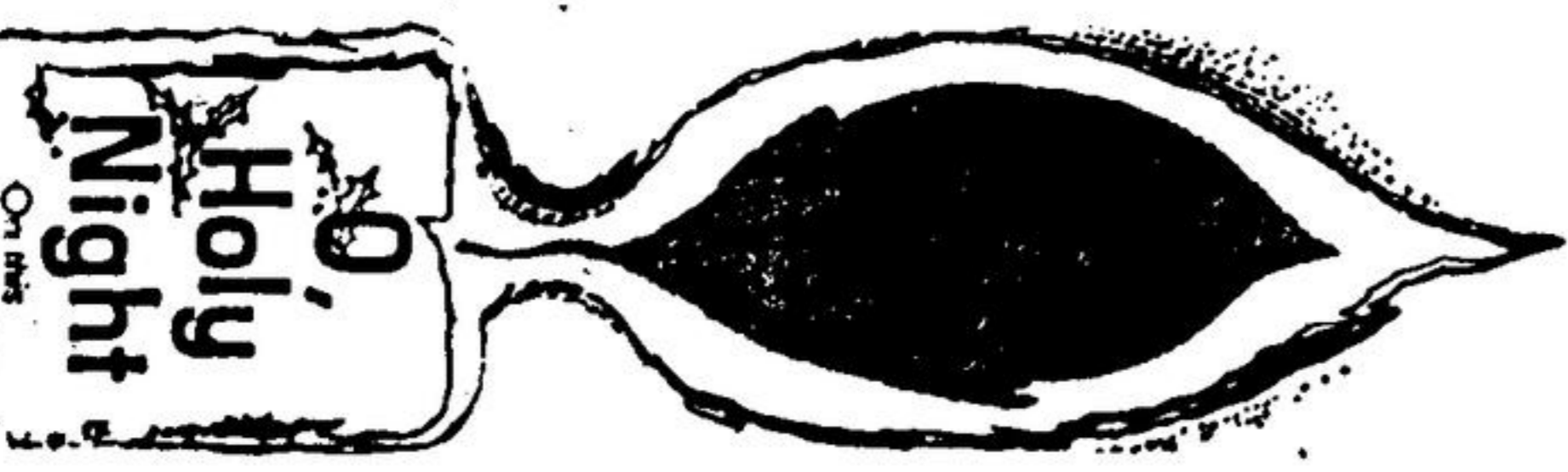

As he thought of birth and life and death and looked down upon the sleepy, starlit village below, Father Mohr found these words: "They sing the praises of the Holy Infant born to the world, and we wonder if they do not also ask for the departed soul." "rest in peace." Thus came the famous "Silent Night, Holy Night." Franz Gruber, true to his word, put Father Mohr's words to music that still endures till the end of time.

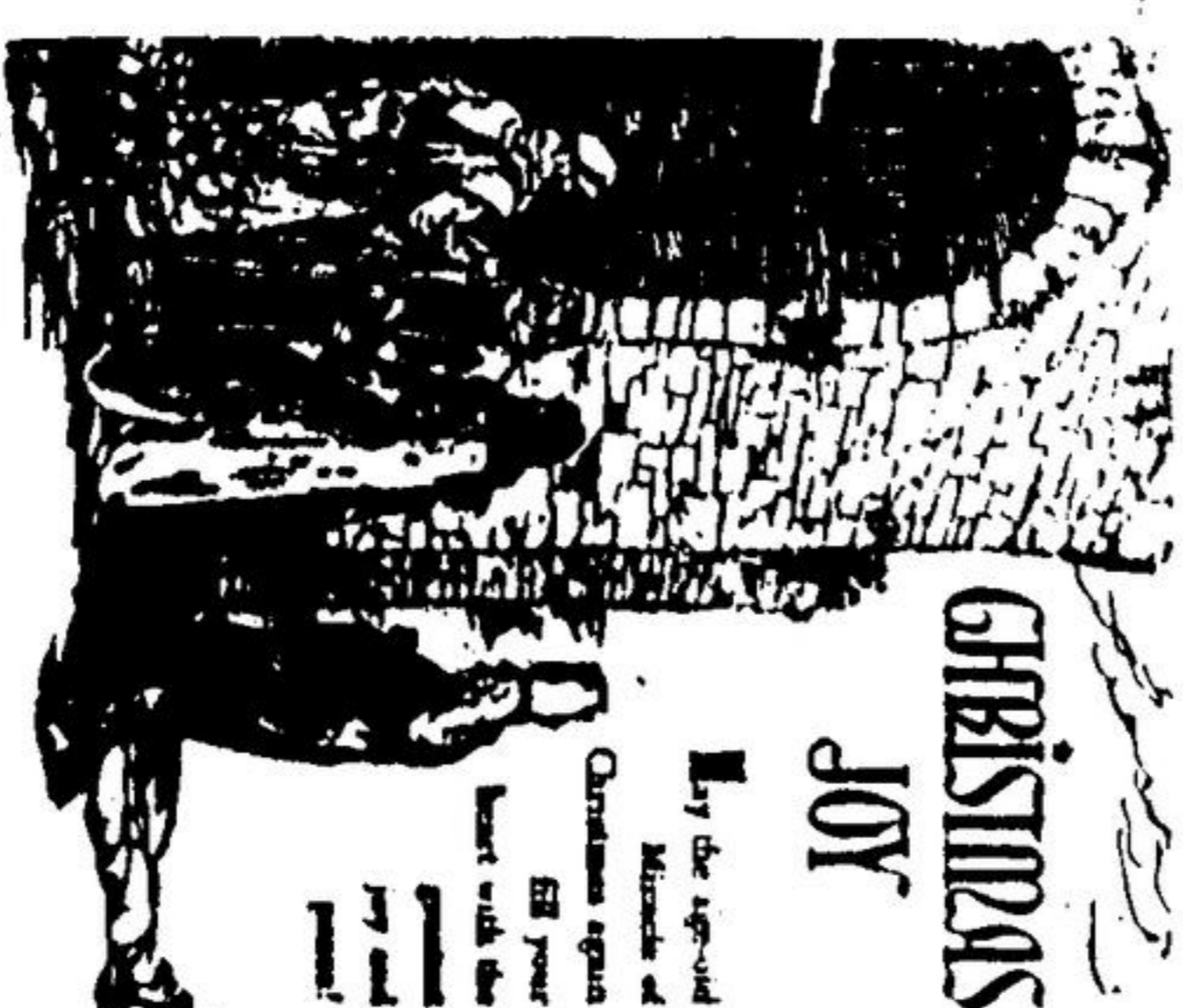

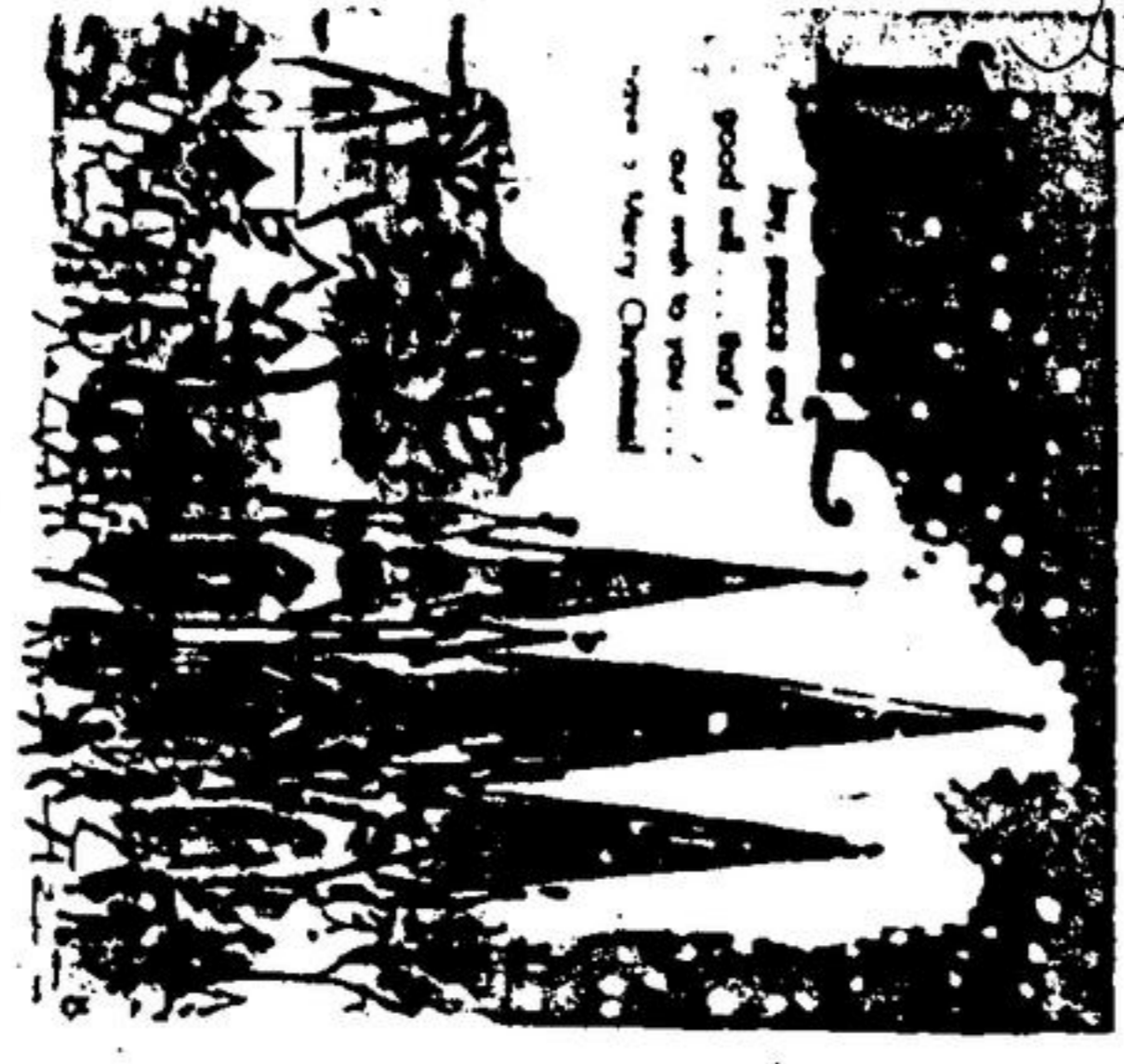
