Tories Lay Campaign Plan

Plans for a full-scale federal election campaign through Halton County are presently being drawn up by Halton Progressive Conservatives and their candidate Dr. Sandy Best of Georgetown, the candidate announced this week.

Dr. Best, who was Conservative M.P. for Halton for five years before being defeated by Liberal Dr. Harry Harley in the June 18 election, said "our chances are very good" for a victory in the coming April 8 election. But "we have a very difficult campaign ahead", he added, noting more feeling of negativism toward all the parties than direct positive support.

Although Dr. Best is campaigning nearly full-time now, most of the preliminary campaign work is "mechanical organizing" of the campaign. And he has plenty of help with P.C. organizations in each Halton municipality ready and willing to help.

Liberals Choosing Candidates

Tonight (Thursday) at the Milton Town Hall, about 500 Halton Liberals are expected to gather to choose their federal and provincial election candidates for the coming campaigns.

To date only two men have announced their intention to seek the two berths—and unless they receive opposition at tonight's nomination meeting, the party will be represented by Dr. Harry C. Harley of Oakville in the federal race, and Mayor Owen McMillan of Burlington in the provincial race. Both are veterans of previous campaigns.

Three Seek Two N.D.P. Seats

Halton New Democratic Party has one federal and two provincial candidates in the running today, just a week before the party's joint federal-provincial nominating convention slated for Oakville Arena on February 28.
