Nassagaweya Rates Climb
M.S. Cost Up Nine Mills

Mill rates for 1963 were set by Nassagaweya Township councillors — and the news for township taxpayers is "generally bad". Nearly all the rates in this complicated mill structure were increased, with the biggest increase in High School costs... an increase of over nine mills in the Acton area, and over six mills for Milton area.

Taxes this year will raise \$161,803.15, an increase of about \$30,000 over last year, clerk Don McMillan explained.

The entire township pays the township general rate of 3.06 mills and county rate \$5.53 mills. High school rate for Acton area is 15.72 mills, and 14.40 for Milton area. Township school area rate is 16.45 mills but the S.S. No. 6 area rate is 8.05 mills.

All ratepayers are subject to a 10.35 mill road rate, except villagers of Campbellville where the rate is 5.81 mills, and Eden Mills where it is 13.02.

Milton fire area levy is 1.48 mills, while Acton's is 1.96.

Commercial rates will run about six mills higher than these.
