WILLIAM JOHNSTONE
Born 1862 - Died 1939
William Johnstone was in born in 1862 at Freedom in Wentworth County. He was in business 10 years in Campbellville. In 1900 he moved to Acton and for 30 years he had the Funeral Home in Acton. In addition he operated a furniture business. Mr. Johnstone's quiet, genial manner and his skillful, well ordered conducting of the Funeral Service won him great popularity as a funeral director and his calls came from far and near. He was elected President of Acton Fair in 1926. He was a strong proponent of the Acton Fair.

W. J. McLEOD
Born 1861 - Died 1939
