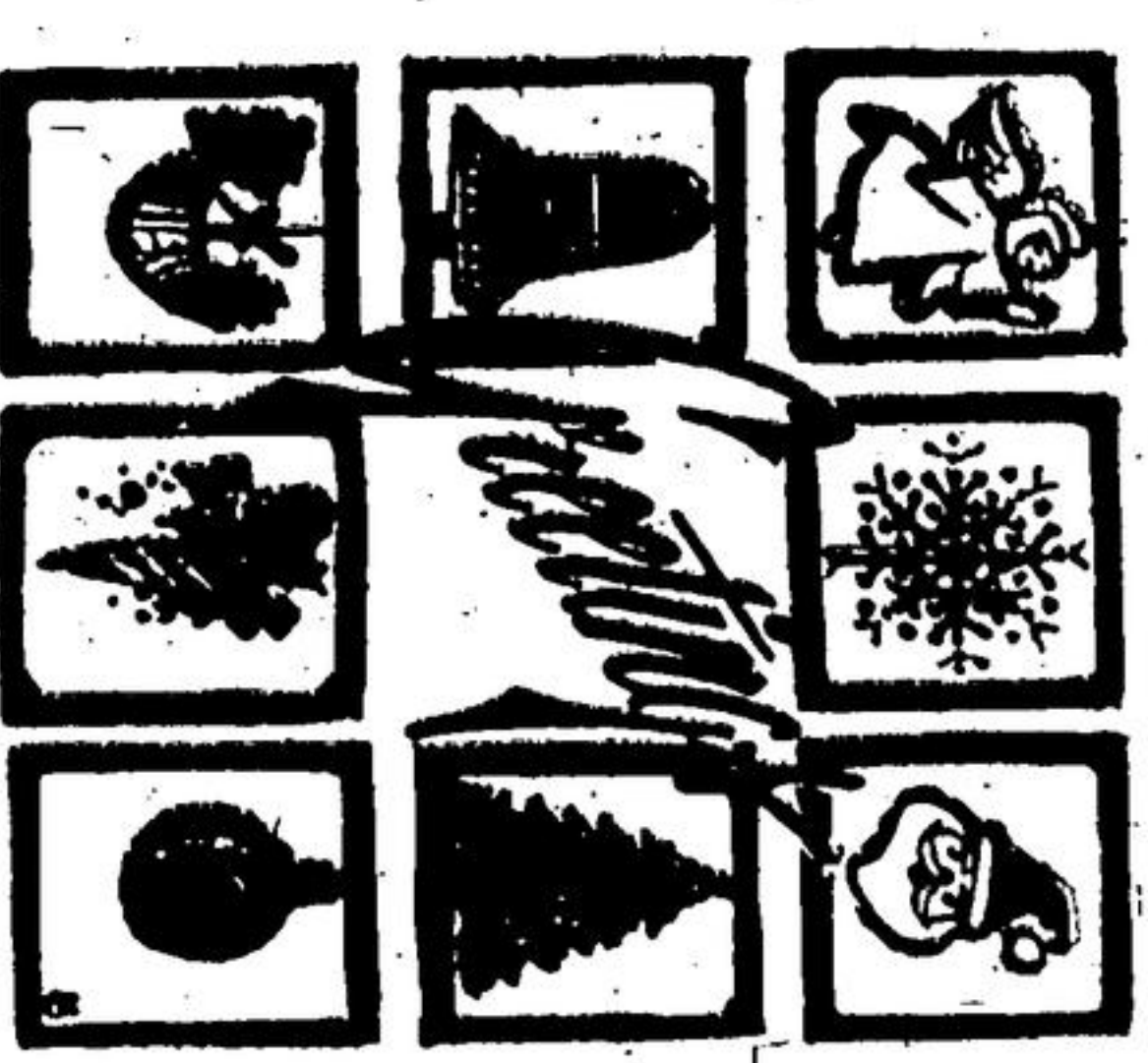

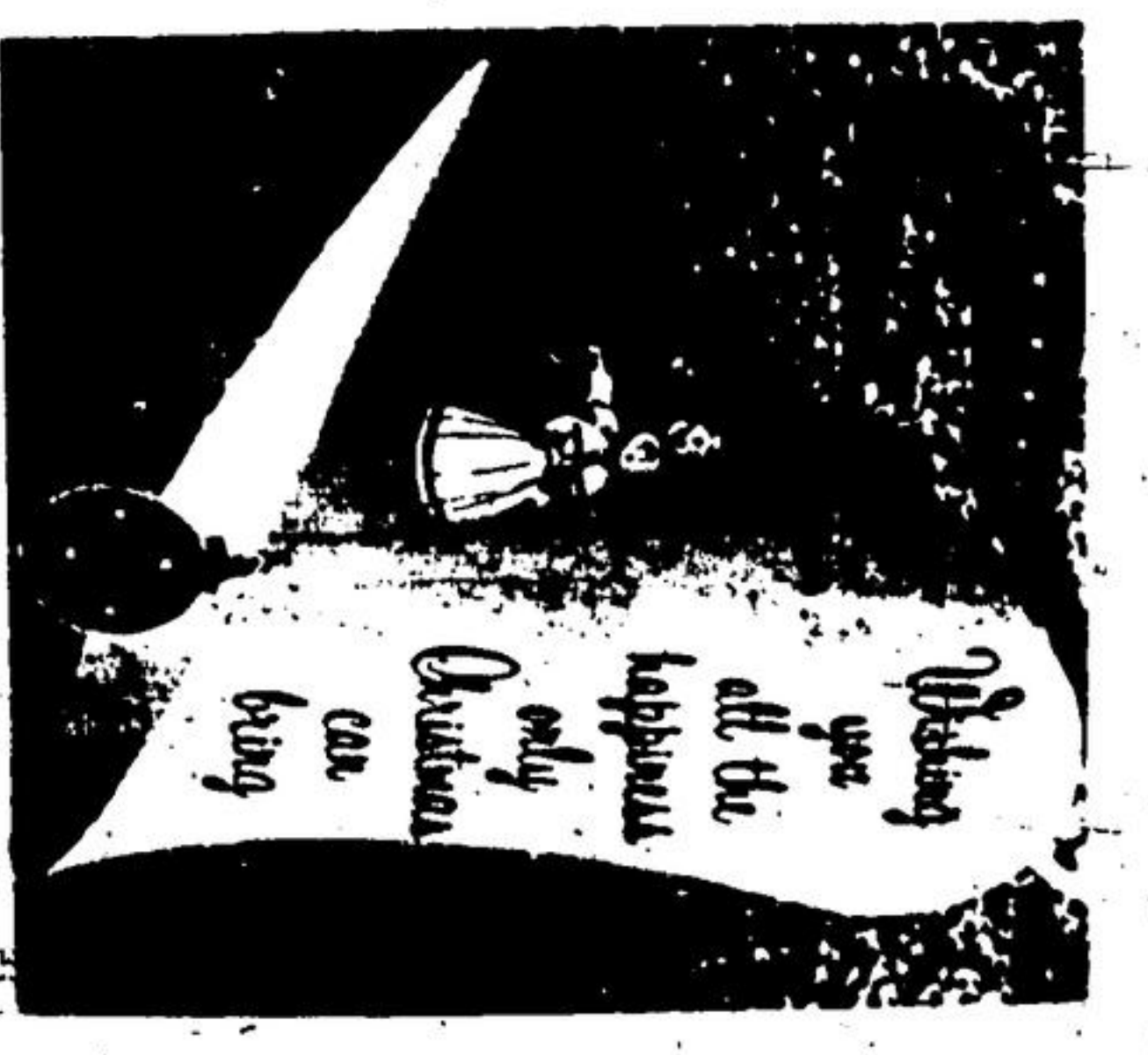

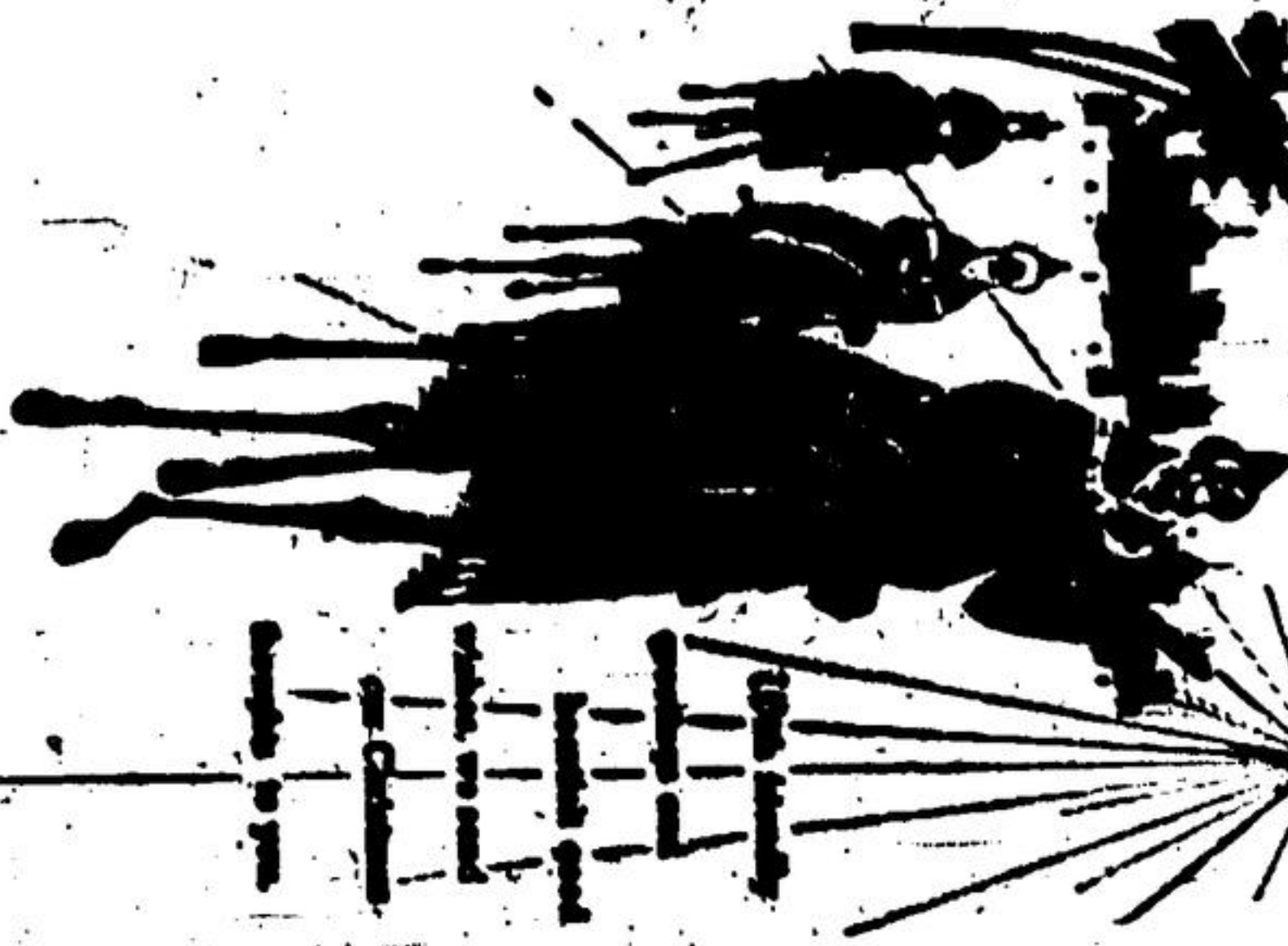
Rules for Solving About Greeting Card Etiquette
