

"Alert" Sounds on Radio Snow Plows Ready to Roll

To date almost the same amount of sand and salt has been used here on highways during sanding runs this year as the same period last year — 3,800 tons.

Although the season for sanding began last year on October 26 and this year it didn't start until December 1, there have been several severe days when the sanding crews were out almost continually night and day.

Stockpiled the first of the season were 8,917 tons of combined salt and sand at the sanding pit near Cresson's Corners. To date 3,800 tons have been used.


