**HALTON COUNCIL BRIEFS**

Halton County Council in its regular session on Tuesday:

- Approved a grant to the Halton Agricultural Society of \$1,000. Representatives had asked consideration of a \$1,500 grant. The county had approved a \$1,500 grant over the previous five years with \$500 to be assistance in construction of a grandstand. The five year period had ended.
- Agreed to a balance of \$289,500 to the Oakville-Trafalgar Memorial Hospital as soon as they receive a certificate from the architect authorizing final payment to the contractor.
- Buy In Yous**  
Authorized the purchase of one ton shipments of duplicating paper to earn a 35 per cent discount.
- Accepted the tender of Gage Envelope Co. for the printing of county envelopes at \$272.42. The tender was the lowest received.

**Two Tots Killed Train-Van Crash**

Kevin and Allan Garbutt, two and three years old, of R.R. 4, Georgetown, were killed instantly when a light delivery van and a train were in collision Tuesday morning. Their father, Donald Garbutt, is in critical condition in Peel Memorial Hospital, Brampton.

The accident occurred at 8:05 a.m. on the fourth line. Chimney level crossing a road north of Highway No. 7 and four miles east of Georgetown. The express train was proceeding east to Toronto and the van was proceeding south.

The children's mother was supplying teaching at Norval, under the Esquimaux area school board. She began over a month ago when Mrs. Caswell broke her leg. Mr. Garbutt had taken the mother to the school and was taking the children to his mother's home for the day.

There are no warning signals at the crossing. There have been other accidents there.

Relatives heard of the accident and rushed to the scene, where they were consoled by Rev. Lloyd Ford of Home United Church. Chinguaousy police investigated.

**Study County Centennial Plan Whiting Calls it "Hot Potato"**

Deputy Reeve Whiting termed the whole thing a "hot potato" out members agreed to consider whether the county committee would be desirable.

Regulations setting out available grants were referred to, and Oakville Deputy Reeve Lester Whiting voiced doubts if Burlington and Oakville would be willing to participate in a county scheme. "We always have to do something if a grant is involved. I'm opposed," he said, noting local municipalities were already dealing with centennial projects.
