## Former Cabinet Minister Blasts Pearson's Pennant

A chicken barbecue, races and games, political speeches and a day full of fun lured over 200 Halton Progressive Conservatives to Lowville Park in North Burlington Sunday afternoon, September 20, for the association's annual picnic and get-together.  
 Former minister of agriculture, the Hon. Alvin Hamilton from Saskatchewan was guest speaker, and among other notables pres-

ent were Halton M.P.P. George Kerr, Warden Gordon Gallagher of Burlington, and Oakville Mayor Allan Masson. All four had short speeches for the crowd, but the majority of the program was devoted to the delicious barbecue chicken and salad supper, and the children's races.  
 The Young Progressive Conservative group did most of the planning for the successful pic-

nic. Poor weather kept the crowd small, however, and there was plenty of extra food left over after all had eaten.  
 Laugh highlight of the day was a three-legged race. The guest speaker and M.P.P. Kerr each tied one leg to the other's, and handily beat out Mayor Masson and Warden Gallagher in two dashes of the race. Later the guest speaker and Mr. Kerr were asked to pick out the child with the most freckles.  
 In a speech to the gathering late in the afternoon, Mr. Hamilton told the crowd the Liberal government had "attempted to thrust the new flag down the throats of the people," and only a strong P.C. opposition had kept the pennant from becoming the country's national flag.  
 He suggested the three leaves were not representative, and outlined his own idea for a Canadian flag — including symbols of our past history and culture and religion. "We must move very cautiously and carefully" in choosing a Canadian flag, Mr. Hamilton said, adding that whatever flag is chosen, it should be approved by at least 80 or 90 per cent of the federal members of parliament.  
 He claimed Prime Minister Lester Pearson had thrown the flag debate at the House to cause "an uproar" that would overshadow the rest of the present government's troubles. Tossing the issue out for open debate, before even consulting all his M.P.'s, was a disastrous move on the P.M.'s part, he added, suggesting that if the flag design had been more carefully presented there was a possibility of unanimity in the house.

"Generations after generations have fought to build this country, and they should not have their rights taken away from them like that," he continued. "The Conservative opposition was determined to give the Canadian people time to consider it" and the Tories' delay soon won support by the other opposition parties and a solid front of opposition was placed before the Liberals.  
 The former Cabinet minister suggested "Parliament is a little prouder today" because the flag debate was halted.  
 He gave his speech from the platform of a truck, standing between a Red Ensign and a Union Jack.
