The great Christmas tree provinces are British Columbia, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec and Ontario. Balsam fir is the first choice in the Maritimes and Douglas fir on the west coast. Many Canadian families prefer spruce, Scots pine and other evergreens, however. One out of every four Christmas trees in American homes comes from Canada.

Turning to the United States — one of the most charming Christmas customs may be found among the Pennsylvania Dutch. They make up their own model Nativity scenes and have great fun going from house to house to see the ones their friends have built. In a church at Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, there is a remarkable Purit or Nativity scene which people come for miles to see. It tells the story of Jesus' birth in seven elaborate scenes.

Christmas trees came to this continent from Germany, in the 16th century. Joy to the World and Hark! The Herald Angels Sing, claimed by both France and England.

Old Carol
"Deck the Halls with Boughs of Holly" is not only an old English carol but also a firm rule in British Yuletide households. Holly branches, with their glossy green leaves and red berries, along with the white-bellied

mistletoe and evergreen boughs,

adorn the Englishman's castle

whether it be a Mayfair flat or a Devon cottage. But all the Christmas decorations are taken on Twelfth Night January 6th.

The first weekday after Christmas Day in England is also the day when the poor man, the milkman and servants receive a gift or box.

The custom of Englishmen was to use the yule log placed in the fireplace. In England it was of ash oak or pine in Scotland birch. It had to be felled from the branch of the tree before it had to be kept burning, otherwise the branch would catch fire.

On Twelfth Night, France

the monks of Mont St. Michel

had a special custom for the 6th of January, Twelfth Night or Epiphany.

They ate cake that had a coin hidden in one of them. The finder became Epiphany king.

He sat on a special throne at Mo

tinique High Mass and Vespers. The Fins do not use evergreen for Christmas decorations. They consider it a sign of mourning.

But they cover the floors of

the houses with straw for the child to sleep on in remembrance of the Magi.

Tree of Light
