**Essay Contest Details**  
The essay contest on "Mental Retardation" will have first, second and third prizes of \$15, \$10 and \$5. The essays, to be submitted to Miss Moulton before April 30, will be considered by independent judges and judged by number rather than name. They are to comprise not less than 1000 words, and neatness and originality will be considered.

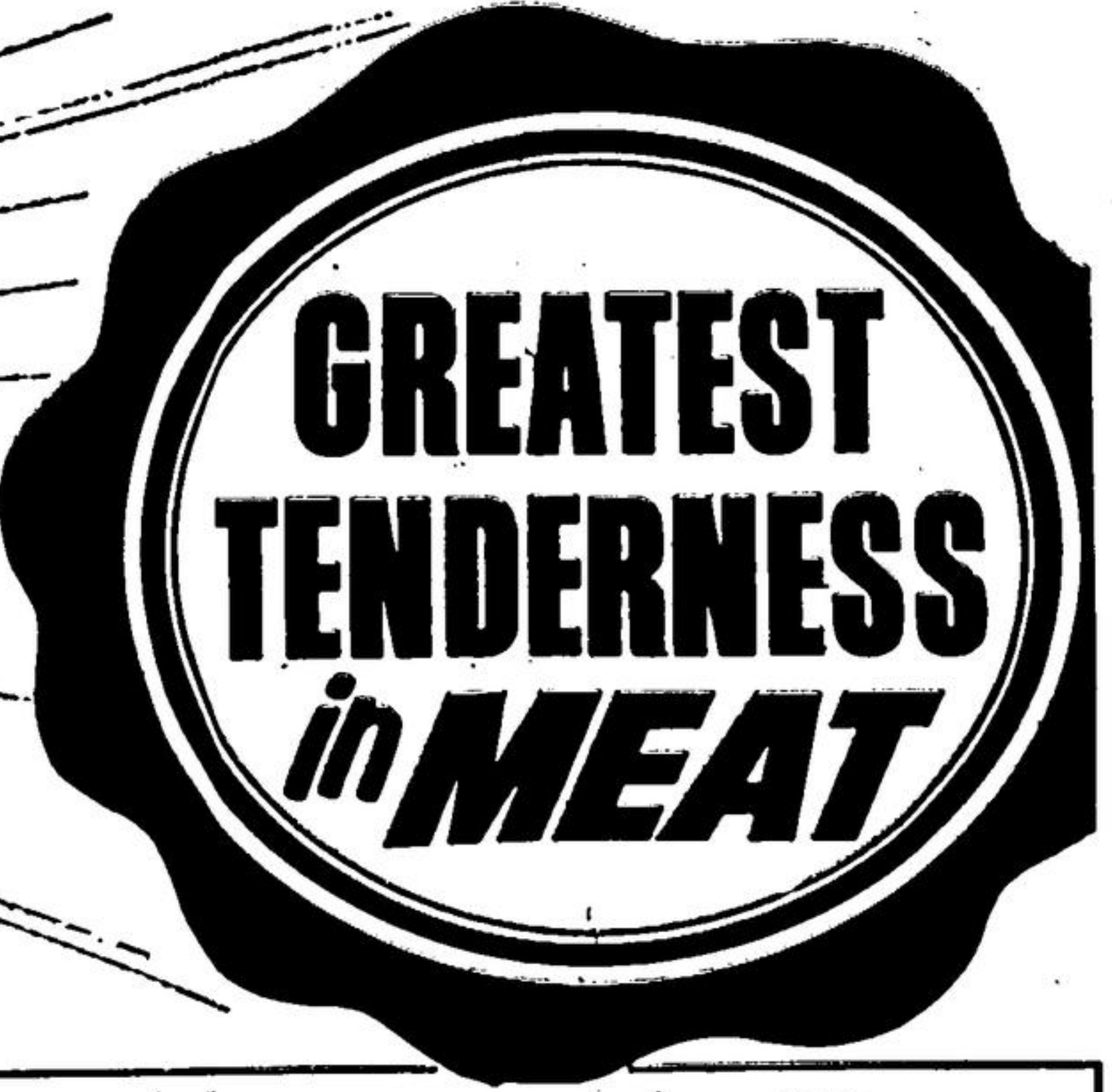
