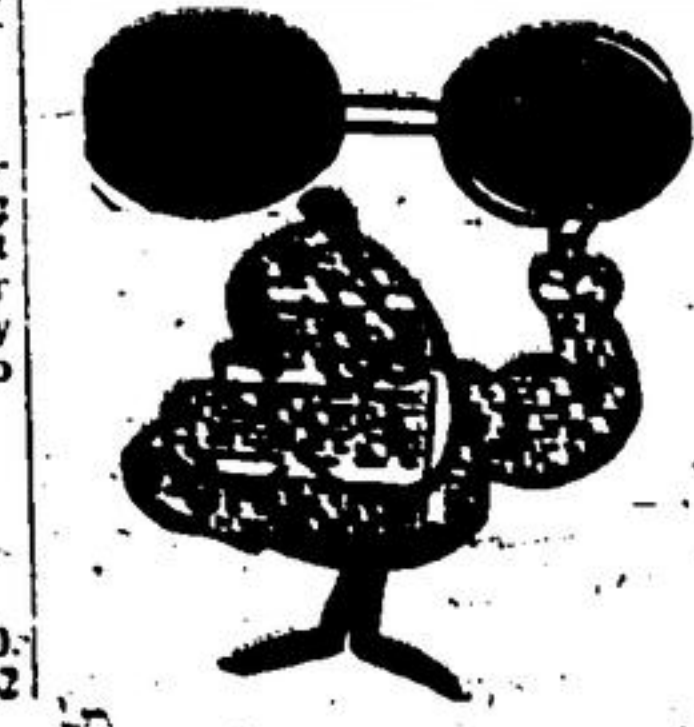

(Continued from Page One) - gram committee members notified the committee several hours' ice time would be purchased each week by Milton hockey club. Program committee chairman Gord James would like the ice in by October 15.
