Dear Friends: This is a Sunday afternoon and we are enjoying a restful time with our family after a week of fellowship with Christian pastors, workers and laymen around a Stewardship theme. This five day Stewardship Institute took place here in Sriakulam. About 30 delegates and seven missionaries came together from September 13-17 when we had group Bible studies, lectures on the nature and mission of the church, and conferences on items of a practical nature relating to stewardship, such as "The Church Budget".
