Rockwood - The hearing on the closing of Valley Road in Rockwood was one main issue passed at the regular Township of Eramosa Council meeting recently. All members were present for this last regular meeting of the year and Reeve Cameron Lush presided.

Also attending were the Rockwood village trustees and their secretary, the building inspector, assessor, clerk and two taxpayers. The minutes of the last regular meeting, the Court of Revision and special moeting were read and adopted.

Seli to Authority Since there were no objections, a motion was passed and carried that a by-law be introduced to authorize the stopping up and selling to the Grand Valley Conservation Authority, all those parts of Fall Street and Valley Road in the Village of Rockwood, lying between the intersection of Rock Street and Fall Street and the west side of the lane on the east side of the stone house now used by the Boy

Scouts as a scout house, Several items of correspondence were discussed, one being to amend sections of by-law No. 11-1956 and repeal by-law No. 10-

The Council, the Board of Trustees and the Building Inspector discussed the proposed amendments and decided to have another joint meeting to further discuss proposed changes.

Boxing Day Monday, December 27. (Boxing Day) was declared a holiday by Council. The members moved a grant of \$25 to the Salvation Army and the treasurer was authorized to include this amount on the December 13 pay voucher.

Council discussed with the Eramosa School chairman and secretary, William Jackson and George Day, their request for an easement for building on the road allowance on Guelph Street, After the matter was discussed the motion was passed that Council instruct the building inspector to issue a permit to the Eramosa School Board to erect a school building on school property in

Rockwood. The Council filled in the questionaire from the Township of Puslinch regarding rabies control and correspondence from the Grand Valley Conservation Authority, Guelph District High School and the Ontario Municipal Board was placed on file.

The treasurer was authorized to include the return of the contractor's gravel deposit of \$300 in the December 13 pay voucher. **New Appointment**

It was moved and carried that the resignation of Howard Smith as the Township representative from the Fergus District High School Board be accepted with regret and the Clerk be instructed to send Mr. Smith a letter of the council's appreciation of his services; also that Romeo Landoni, R.R. 1, Rockwood, be appointed as the council's representative on the Fergus District High School Board for a two year term, 1966-68.

Franklin Armstrong was re-appointed to represent the Township on the Groves Memorial Community Hospital Board.

Snow Fence The road superintendent avas authorized to purchase sufficient steel posts to erect the snow fence previously ordered, and the Council instructed the Clerk to contact Mr. May, representative of the Frank Cowan Insurance Company, asking him to attend a meeting at the Town Hall Rockwood on Tuesday, December 28. Accounts amounting to \$101. 963.71, (road accounts \$1,347.43; general accounts \$100.616.28, including county and school board requisitions) were passed for payment and the meeting adjourned to meet on January 3, or at the call of the reeve.
