

**I.O.D.E. Observes 66th Birthday**

The I.O.D.E. (Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire) will celebrate its 66th birthday on February 13.

The results of the work accomplished by the Order's 976 chapters penetrate to all corners of the globe and at Founder's Day meetings from coast to coast, the members of the two chapters in town will join many others in reminiscing with pride on the growth of the Order from one woman's dream (Mrs. Clark Murray, the founder) to the strong and outstanding reality which is today. This national organization—a Canadian organization—raises and disburses annually over \$1,000,000 for education, emergency and disaster relief.

In the field of service, the I.O.D.E. continues to make a worthy contribution, both at home and abroad, amounting to approximately half a million dollars annually. The amount of \$325,000 is spent on welfare in Canada, and \$115,000 on relief supplies to the needy which are shipped to Europe, Africa, Korea, the West Indies, Hong Kong and India. This includes the sponsorship of destitute and refugee children.

In the past year, 600 cases were shipped to the emerging countries. Eleven years ago, X-ray equipment was provided for the TB children in Korea. Each year, the supporting supplies such as X-ray developer, film and parts necessary for the maintenance of the unit are sent—the cost amounting to \$3,600 annually. Members again enthusiastically packed Christmas parcels for the Eskimo and Indian children in Community Centres and on reservations in the Far North.

Over \$350,000 is spent on educational projects by the Order and the work continues to expand. Sixty-four schools and 10 hostels in the North-West Territories have been adopted by the chapters, as well as 36 schools in Northern and Southern Labrador and 81 remote and isolated schools in Newfoundland. The I.O.D.E. has also adopted secondary schools in the West Indies and British Honduras. School adoption constitutes gifts of new libraries, prize books, records, pianos, geographic slides, projectors and varied visual aids.

Canadian Arts continue to be supported by the I.O.D.E. in each province. There are many bursaries and scholarships.

The I.O.D.E. Canadian Centenary Fund has a minimum objective of \$50,000. This fund, to which all members have been contributing, will be shared equally by all 10 provinces as well as an allocation to the Yukon Territory. Each province has a special educational project to commemorate Canada's Centennial Year, which will be financed from their share of the fund.

**Grand Jury Blasts Jail**

Provisions for a new county jail, larger and proper facilities for the Children's Aid Society and the erection of a dignified sign outside the County Court House, were the major recommendations offered by the Grand Jury when it inspected Halton County's facilities.

In its report to Mr. Justice Moorehouse, the seven-member jury described present jail facilities as being inadequate and suggested new facilities should be built as soon as possible. The jury was also concerned with the large turn-over of staff at the jail and indicated nine of the 12 regular staff members left during 1965.

**Short of Space**

Insufficient space (only nine rooms for 15 to 21 employees) for the Children's Aid Society should be rectified, the report stated.

Present parking facilities at the Court House and Administration Building were also condemned.

**Dignified Sign**

Members suggested a "large and dignified sign" should be erected. The present sign is inadequate, Mr. Justice Moorehouse also criticized the current wooden sign at the entrance to the parking lot.

The jury also recommended that jury rooms have their windows frosted over to prevent jury tampering.

In addition to the recommendations from the jury, Mr. Justice Moorehouse ordered the installation of a buzzer system in court after having to wait several minutes for the arrival of the members of the jury and several lawyers.
